PIAZZA MAGIORE

In the heart of Bologna you will find Piazza Maggiore, literally translated "big square." The entire square is surrounded by beautiful medieval buildings, cozy streets and restaurants where you can enjoy delicious food. The highlight is the Neptune Fountain that adorns the square.

Bologna used to be the city of towers. Most of the towers have now been demolished, but the two gigantic towers Torre Garisenda and Torre Degli Asinelli are still there and are the symbol of Bologna. Did you know that the Torre Garisena is more leaning than the Tower of Pisa? From the top you have a view over the city.

BASILICA OF SAN PETRONIO

Located on Piazza Maggiore, stands the remarkable Basilica di San Petronio, a pivotal and expansive church within Bologna. Spanning 132 meters in length and 66 meters in width, it ranks as the world's tenth-largest church.

ARCHAEOLOGICAL MUSEUM

Housed within a historical structure once functioning as a hospice, the museum showcases treasures spanning Etruscan, Greek, and Egyptian eras. The renowned Egyptian exhibit stands as one of Europe's finest, while the impressive assortment of Roman artifacts also captivates visitors.
