How to Get There

Did you book individual hotel stays plus transfers with Race Experience? Then transfers to the circuit are included

Other than that, the circuit can only be reached by public transport. Via <u>9292</u> you can easily see the fastest and easiest way to get to the circuit.

Opening Hours

Throughout the whole race weekend, the track opens at 8:30 in the morning.

Sanitary Facilities

Restrooms are located throughout the track. Pay attention to the signs directing you to the nearest restroom. At many Grand Prix circuits, the majority of toilets are temporary facilities set up specifically for the race weekend. While they are designed to meet sanitation standards and offer basic amenities, their temporary nature might mean variations in size, capacity, or comfort compared to permanent facilities.

Food and Drinks

There is a wide range of food and drink options on the circuit. You can choose between pizza, hot dogs, burgers and street food dishes, among others. At the venue, you can only pay with cards; they don't accept cash for any transactions.

Be advised that it is prohibited to bring your own food and drinks to Zandvoort Circuit. However, you are allowed to bring an (empty) refillable water bottle that you can refill at one of the refill stations.

Walking Distance

Visiting a Grand Prix often involves covering considerable distances. Be sure to wear comfortable shoes for all the walking required of you, and wear comfortable clothing.

Taking Pictures

Taking photos is allowed, but only with a simple camera. Attention will also be paid to obstructing the view of other spectators. The enjoyment of other spectators should not be interfered by anyone, so we advise spectators to always pay attention to others.

Recommended to Bring

- ID proof and entrance ticket;
- Sun protection;
- Sturdy walking shoes;
- Hearing protection;
- Photo camera incl. extra battery and memory card;
- Your printed ticket.

Circuit Access Criteria

In case you are wondering whether something is allowed or not, please refer to the list below. All unauthorized items must be dropped off at the circuit entrance gates. Circuit staff have the right to add other items to the list

- Aerosols (deodorant, mosquito repellent, etc.)
- (Domestic) animals
- Barbecues or (electric) cooking devices
- Bags or backpacks larger than 20 liters; Luggage and trolley
- Cans, metal and glass bottles
- Drones
- Drugs
- (Electronic) cigars/cigarettes
- Fireworks, smoke bombs, rockets, laser pointers, stadium horns
- Flagpoles and umbrellas
- Food and drinks
- Hazardous objects
- Harmful and flammable substances
- Mirror reflex cameras or video cameras
- Tents and sleeping bags
- Vehicles (bicycles, scooters, etc.)
