It provides essential information and insights for visitors attending a Grand Prix, offering details about the access points, food and drinks stand, prohibited items and more of the racing circuit.



# YAS MARINA CIRCUIT

The Yas Marina Circuit is a unique circuit designed by the famous Formula 1 circuit architect Hermann Tilke. The Formula 1 race in Abu Dhabi is, as usual, the closing event on the Formula 1 calendar. The special Yas Marina Circuit in the United Arab Emirates is half an hour's drive from the city of Abu Dhabi. The circuit is 5,281 meters long and has 16 corners.

The 2021 Formula One season culminated in Abu Dhabi with Lewis Hamilton and Max Verstappen contending for the championship title. A last-lap showdown followed a safety car intervention and a debated decision, ultimately favoring Verstappen with fresh tires, securing his victory over Hamilton in a thrilling finale that captivated motorsport fans worldwide.





#### **How To Get There**

During the race weekend, a taxi is a good way to get to the circuit. These can be found everywhere in Abu Dhabi. A taxi from the center to Yas Island costs about 70 dirhams and will drop you off directly in front of the circuit.

There are also free shuttle buses that take spectators after the race to large parking lots where there are plenty of taxis waiting to take you back to the hotel.

#### **Opening Hours**

The circuit opens its doors during the weekend on:

- Friday at 10:30;
- Saturday at 10:30;
- Sunday at 10:30.

#### Walking distance

A visit to a Grand Prix often involves covering many kilometers. Make sure you wear comfortable shoes for any walking that is required of you, and wear comfortable clothing.





#### **Food and Drinks**

There are various food stands everywhere on the circuit. The Yas Marina Circuit also has several restaurants, but it can get very busy here. Alcohol is available on the circuit, but consumption is only permitted in special areas. You must also be at least 21 years old to drink in the United Arab Emirates. It is not allowed to bring your own food and drinks.

#### **Taking Photos On Track**

Taking photos is allowed, but only with a simple camera. Attention is also paid to any interference with the view of other spectators. The enjoyment of other spectators should not be hindered by anyone and therefore we recommend that spectators always pay attention to others.

Video cameras or other professional recording equipment are not permitted during Formula 1.

#### Gates

Seven gates provide access to the circuit via the main access road that runs around the north and west of the circuit.

Free shuttle buses run regularly between the entrances, providing easy access to all stands, the marina, hotels, Etihad Park (where the concerts are held) and Ferrari World.

To enter the Main Stand, enter via Gate 14 and walk through the tunnel to the inside of the circuit using Gate 16.

We recommend the Yas Hub App for your phone. In the app you will find, among other things, a map of the circuit.



#### **Toilets**

Restrooms are located throughout the track. Pay attention to the signs directing you to the nearest restroom. At many Grand Prix circuits, the majority of toilets are temporary facilities set up specifically for the race weekend. While they are designed to meet sanitation standards and offer basic amenities, their temporary nature might mean variations in size, capacity, or comfort compared to permanent facilities.

#### **Entertainment**

There will also be After-Race Concerts at Etihad Park.

- All ticket holders have access on Thursday;
- 1-day ticket holders have access to the concert on the day of their ticket and to the concert on Thursday;
- 2-day ticket holders have access to the concerts on Thursday, Saturday and Sunday;
- 3-day ticket holders have access to all 4 concerts from Thursday to Sunday.

#### Recommended to take with you to the circuit

- ID and entrance ticket;
- Sun protection (sunscreen should only come from a plastic bottle);
- Sturdy walking shoes;
- Hearing protection;
- Photo camera incl. extra battery and memory card;
- Your printed ticket.



#### Entrance criteria for the circuit

If you are wondering whether or not something is allowed, please consult the list below. All unauthorized items must be surrendered at the circuit entrance gates. The circuit staff have the right to add other items to the list.

- (Pets;
- Alcoholic drinks and drugs;
- Barbecues or (electric) cooking appliances;
- Cans, metal and glass bottles;
- Drones;
- Food and drink;
- Dangerous objects;
- Glass packaging and/or objects;
- Harmful and flammable substances;
- Aerosols (deodorant, mosquito repellent, etc.)
- Tents and sleeping bags;
- Flagpoles and parasols;
- Vehicles (bicycles, scooters, etc.)
- Fireworks, smoke bombs, rockets, laser pointers, stadium horns.
