#### Shanghai International Circuit: A Thrilling Test of Speed and Precision

The Shanghai International Circuit, host of the Formula 1 Chinese Grand Prix, exemplifies a challenging mix of speed and precision.

Designed by Hermann Tilke, the 5.451-kilometer circuit features long straights and complex corners, such as the iconic Turn 1 and Turn 13, that test the skills of drivers.

With one of the longest straights in Formula 1, it provides a challenging environment for strategic racing, where speed and control go hand in hand. This circuit is known for its spectacular races that captivate fans around the world, thanks to its unique layout and the opportunity for strategic maneuvers, making it an essential part of the Formula 1 season and a firm fan favorite.

#### THE RACE IN 2023



Lewis Hamilton won the thousandth Formula One race in Shanghai, with Valtteri Bottas and Sebastian Vettel behind him.

Mercedes dominated the race, while Ferrari and Red Bull struggled to keep up. Max Verstappen finished fourth, but the race offered little spectacle.

Hamilton took the lead at the start, while Verstappen trailed his teammate Gasly. After a collision between McLarens and Kvyat, no overtaking was allowed for two laps. When the race resumed, the Mercedes were too fast for the rest of the field. Verstappen, with an early pit stop, kept Vettel and Leclerc behind.

Despite a lack of speed, Verstappen was satisfied with fourth place. Kvyat received a penalty for his actions on the track, while Leclerc received team orders to let Vettel go ahead.

#### HOW TO GET TO CIRCUIT?

The circuit is about 35 kilometers from downtown Shanghai. There are several ways to get to the circuit by public transportation or taxis.

#### Metro

The circuit has its own subway station on line 11. From downtown Shanghai, it takes about an hour to get to Shanghai International Circuit.

Note: Take line 11 in the direction of Huaqiao. "Shanghai Circuit" station is 300 meters from Gate 1 and 500 meters from Gate 11. There have also been occasions in previous years when the station was closed due to overcrowding. Should this happen, you can get off at the next stop and take a taxi back to the circuit.

#### Taxi

There are plenty of taxis you can use to get to the circuit. However, keep in mind that there will be long traffic jams which will make travel time longer than normal from downtown Shanghai (normally it takes 45 minutes).







#### **SANITARY FACILITIES**

There are sufficient (temporary) toilets available on the circuit. Look out for signs directing you to the nearest toilet. In general, the toilets are kept very clean. The toilets can be very busy during a Grand Prix weekend, espeically right before a Formula 1 session.



#### WEATHER & CLIMATE

In April, the weather in Shanghai is usually mild and pleasant, with temperatures ranging between 15°C and 20°C. Precipitation is possible, but generally the days are sunny with occasional clouds. It can still feel a bit cool, so it is wise to bring a jacket for the China Grand Prix.



#### WALKING DISTANCE AT CIRCUIT

During a Grand Prix weekend, expect plenty of walking. Hence, opt for comfortable shoes and attire to avoid blisters and discomfort. Pick clothing that allows easy movement, ensuring you can fully enjoy the event.



#### TAKING PHOTOS

It is allowed to take photos on the circuit with a simple camera for personal use. Pay attention to other spectators and avoid obstructing their view. Be respectful to fellow Formula 1 fans.







#### FOOD & DRINKS

Food and drinks are not expensive by F1 standards, but keep in mind that food and drinks are always quite pricey. There is a fairly limited supply of food and drink. Think mainly of hamburgers, fries and noodles. In previous editions, there were more food and drink stands outside and around the track.



#### ENTERTAINMENT & ACTIVITIES

In Shanghai, be sure to visit the Heineken Music Zone at the P3 parking lot of the Shanghai International Circuit, war DJs bands and singer-songwriters perform from noon to night.



The F1 Fan Zone at the Chinese Grand Prix is located behind the Main Grandstand. Here you will find interactive activities, merchandise stands and various food and drink stands. The Fan Zone is a vibrant hub where fans can enjoy entertainment and experience a sense of connection to the world of Formula 1.



The F1 app provides real-time updates on positions, times and pit stops and it enhances the racing experience with live audio and team radios. We recommend downloading the app on your phone for the best experience on the track.
