# JEDDAH CORNICHE CIRCUIT

The Jeddah Corniche Circuit, an exciting addition to the Formula 1 calendar, made its debut in December 2021. This modern track, located along the picturesque Jeddah Corniche in Saudi Arabia, presents drivers with a unique set of challenges. While many appreciated its innovative design, feedback was mixed, particularly regarding visibility and safety concerns in certain corners.

Responding promptly to criticisms, race organizers took action to enhance safety measures before the subsequent race just four months later. Notable adjustments included moving back the walls at bends 2, 3, 14, and 21, providing drivers with better visibility and the ability to anticipate potential hazards.

Spanning an impressive 6,174 meters with 27 corners and three DRS zones, the Jeddah Corniche Circuit stands out as the fastest street circuit on the Formula 1 calendar, with drivers reaching average speeds of 250 kilometers per hour. The proximity to walls adds an extra layer of excitement, particularly during qualifying sessions, as drivers navigate the challenging circuit with precision and skill.





# **CIRCUIT INFORMATION**

#### **How To Get There?**

For the race weekend at the Jeddah Cornice Circuit, the most convenient transportation options are taxis or Uber. With Uber, you're provided with the price upfront, while negotiating fares in advance is advised for regular taxis.

Free parking is available, but you must obtain a pass beforehand from the visitor center, presenting your e-ticket. Designated parking areas are allocated for General Admission, Central Grandstand, Main Grandstand, Paddock Club, and individuals with disabilities. Complimentary shuttles operate from the parking lots to the circuit entrances, ensuring seamless access for all attendees.

#### **Opening hours**

The circuit welcomes visitors daily starting at 1:00 PM. On Thursdays, it remains open until midnight, while on Fridays and Saturdays, it closes at 11:00 PM.





## **CIRCUIT INFORMATION**

#### **Food & Drinks**

Food and beverage stalls are conveniently located throughout the circuit. The Saudi Arabia GP app provides detailed information on the precise locations of these stalls. For dining at restaurants in Marina and Jeddah Art Promenade, advance reservations are necessary.

Please note that alcohol sales and consumption are strictly prohibited on the circuit premises.

#### **Sanitary Facilities**

Restrooms are located throughout the track. Pay attention to the signs directing you to the nearest restroom. At many Grand Prix circuits, the majority of toilets are temporary facilities set up specifically for the race weekend. While they are designed to meet sanitation standards and offer basic amenities, their temporary nature might mean variations in size, capacity, or comfort compared to permanent facilities.

#### **Walking distance**

Attending a Grand Prix usually entails a considerable amount of walking. It is essential to wear comfortable shoes that can withstand the walking demands, along with comfortable clothing.

#### Taking photos on the track

Taking photos is allowed, but only with a simple camera. Attention is also paid to any interference with the view of other spectators. The enjoyment of other spectators should not be hindered by anyone and therefore we recommend that spectators always pay attention to others.


#### Recommended to take with you to the circuit

#### **Entrance criteria for the circuit**

If you are wondering whether or not something is allowed, please consult the list below. All unauthorized items must be surrendered at the circuit entrance gates. The circuit staff have the right to add other items to the list

- (Pets;
- Alcoholic drinks and drugs;
- Barbecues or (electric) cooking appliances;
- Cans, metal and glass bottles;
- Drones;
- Food and drink;
- Dangerous objects;
- Glass packaging and/or objects;
- Harmful and flammable substances;
- Aerosols (deodorant, mosquito repellent, etc.)
- Tents and sleeping bags;
- Flagpoles and parasols;
- Vehicles (bicycles, scooters, etc.)
- Fireworks, smoke bombs, rockets, laser pointers, stadium horns.
