TEXAS STATE CAPITOL

The Texas State Capitol dominates the Austin skyline, commanding immediate attention. As the second largest capitol building in the United States, it offers self-guided or guided tours for visitors. Discover its grandeur and history firsthand, ensuring an enriching experience in the heart of Texas.



BARTON SPRINGS POOL

Located near downtown Austin within Zilker Park, Barton Springs Pool offers a rejuvenating retreat. Its crystal-clear blue waters, with a year-round temperature of approximately 20°C, create a welcoming environment for families. Equipped with diving boards and lifeguard supervision, it's an ideal destination for relaxation and recreation. Despite occasional crowds, its spaciousness ensures ample room for everyone to enjoy.

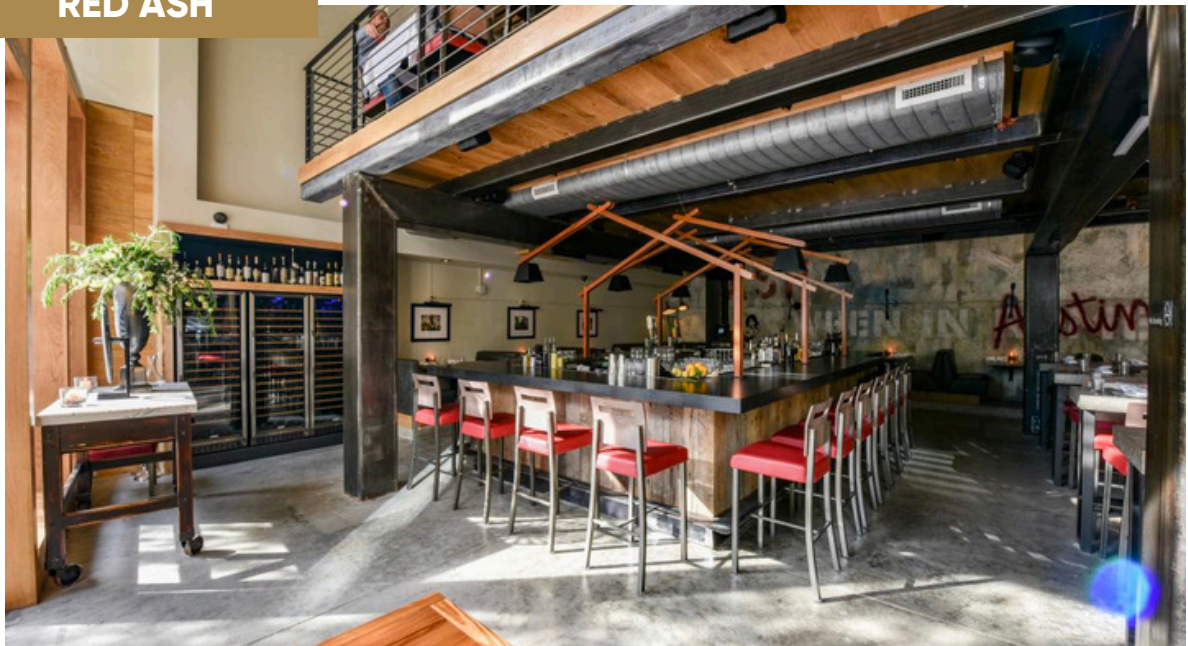
TRACE
