# SÃO PAULO ART MUSEUM

The Museu de Arte de São Paulo is the most important museum in Brazil. It is based on New York's Museum of Modern Art and is located in Parque do Ibirapuera. There is a permanent collection on display with important artists from the Middle Ages to the present. The temporary exhibitions usually have a Brazilian theme.

Entrance is free on Tuesdays.
