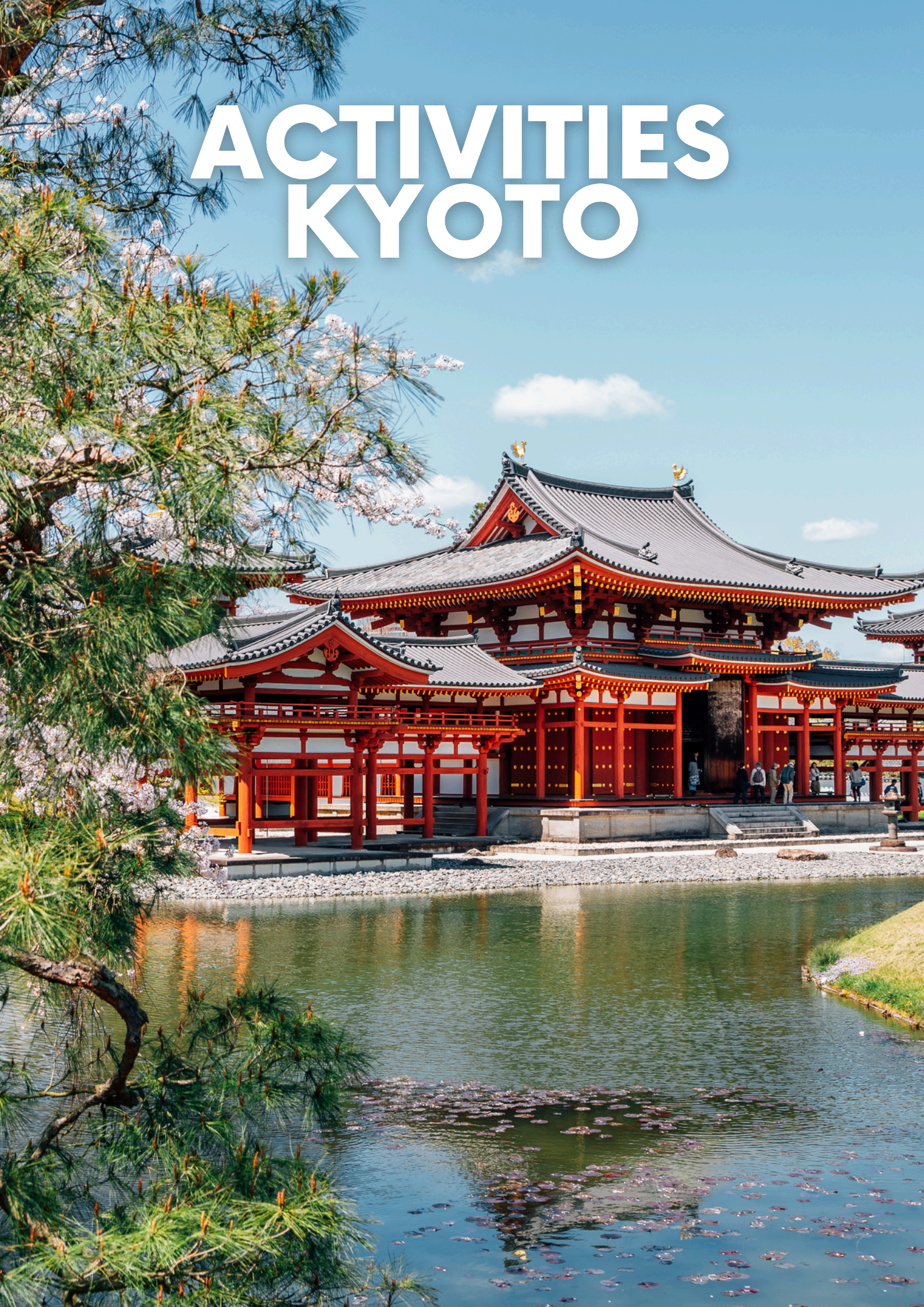

FUSHIMI INARI-TAISHA TEMPLE

One of Japan's most renowned landmarks is the Fushimi-Inari temple, the oldest in Kyoto, dating back to the eighth century. Perched on a mountain, it boasts a mesmerizing trail of thousands of red gates winding through its grounds. As you venture further along the path, the crowds gradually thin out, offering a serene experience.



KINKAKU-JI TEMPLE

The Kinkaku-ji temple stands as one of the city's most renowned landmarks, earning the nickname "Golden Pavilion." Adorned with gold-covered walls, pillars, and decks, it exudes opulence and grandeur. Although the original structure was destroyed by a fire in 1950, it was rebuilt and has been a UNESCO World Heritage site since the turn of the century.



KIYOMIZU-DERA TEMPLE

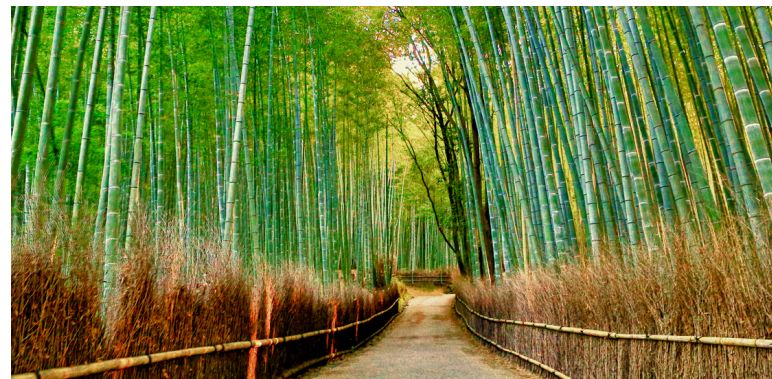

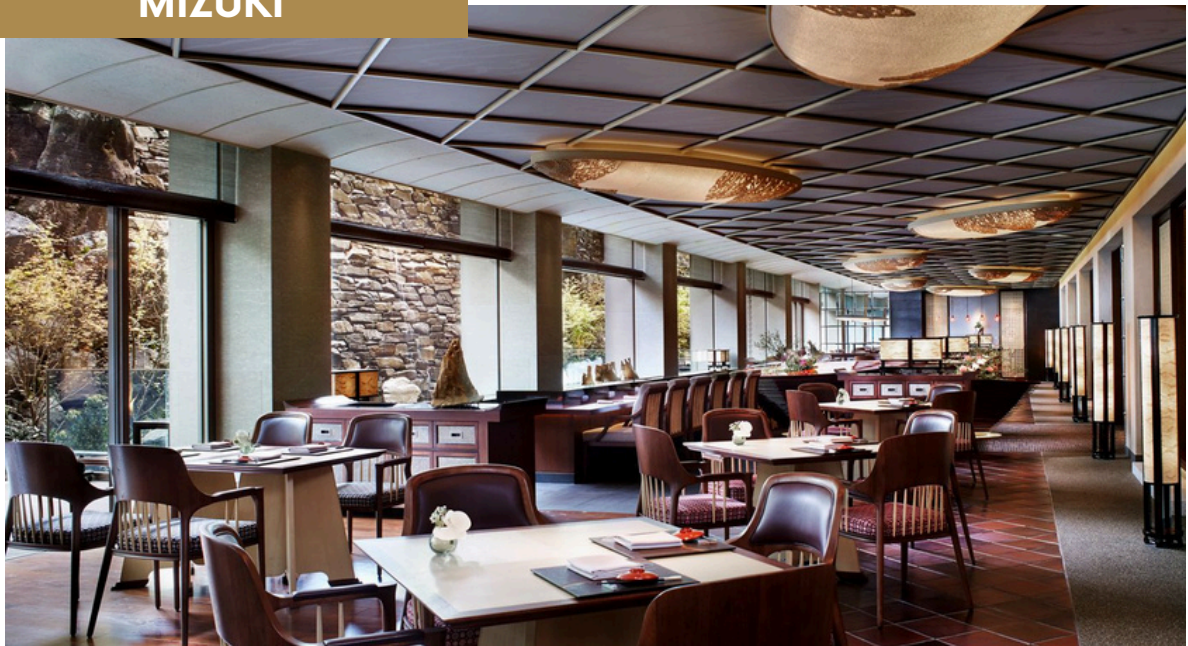

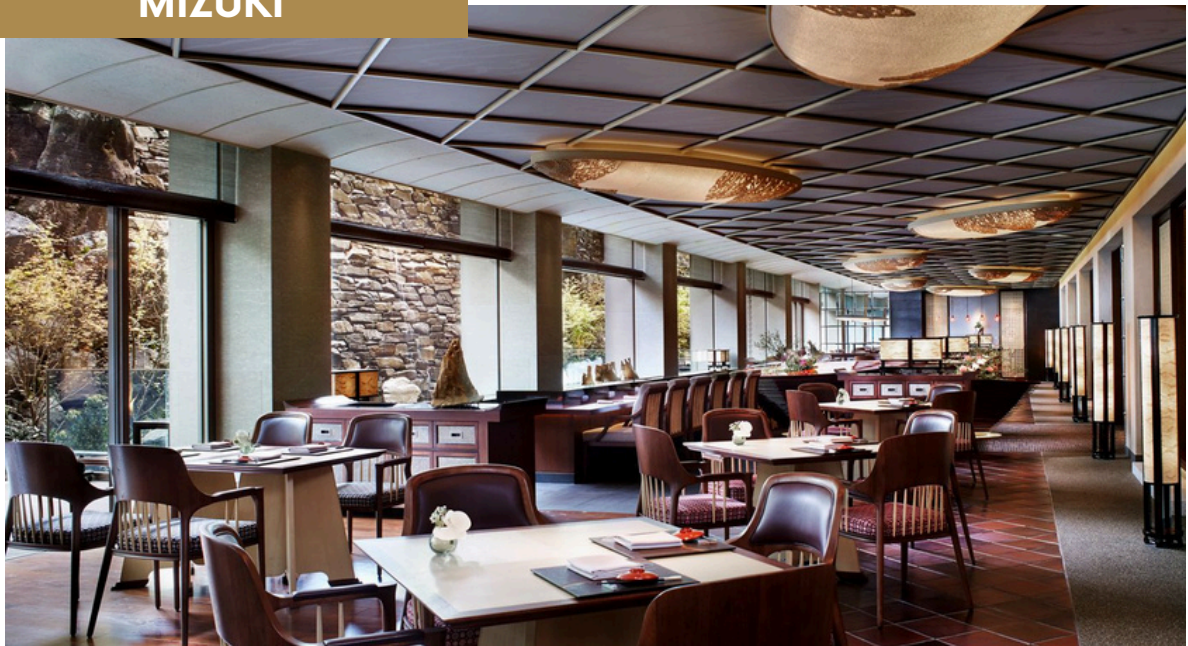
SUGARHILL KYOTO
