# ACTIVITIES IN MEXICO

## ZÓCALO

Zócalo stands as the heart of Mexico City, boasting one of the world's largest squares and serving as the gateway to exploring the city. Each day, at 8:00 am, soldiers ceremoniously hoist the flag, while at 6:00 pm, it is respectfully lowered. This event is a captivating spectacle featuring drummers, trumpets, and marching soldiers.



## NATIONAL PALACE

The National Palace, known as Palacio Nacional, serves as the official residence and workplace of the President of Mexico. Visitors can explore its grandeur at no cost. The palace features a stunning courtyard adorned with diverse succulents, cacti, and remarkable murals by Diego Rivera. Remember to bring your passport (original, not a copy) for entry.



## FRIDA KAHLO MUSEUM

Frida Kahlo, celebrated as one of Mexico's foremost artists, gained renown for her distinctive appearance, tumultuous relationship with Diego Rivera, and exceptional artistry. La Casa Azul, Kahlo's childhood residence, now serves as a museum where visitors can admire her works and delve into her life story.



## TEMPLO MAYOR

Templo Mayor stands as a revered temple ruin nestled in the heart of the city, situated directly behind Zócalo Square. Within the temple precinct lies a museum boasting an impressive collection dating back to the Aztec era. Explore the museum's eight rooms, delving into the southern rooms dedicated to Huitzilopochtli, the sun god of war, and the northern rooms devoted to Tlaloc, the god of rain.
