

SINGAPORE FLYER

Between 2008 and 2014, the Singapore Flyer held the title of the world's largest Ferris wheel. A single ride on this iconic attraction typically lasts around 30 minutes, offering passengers breathtaking views of the entire city. On clear days, the vistas extend to the coastlines of Indonesia and Malaysia, enhancing the experience. It's advisable to board the Ferris wheel shortly before sunset; witnessing the city gradually transition from daylight to darkness is a mesmerizing sight that shouldn't be missed.



Gardens By The Bay stands as Singapore's most renowned gardens, if not globally. Situated in Marina Bay, the park spans about 100 hectares. Its iconic futuristic trees captivate, yet it offers more. Explore attractions like the Flower Dome, Cloud Forest, OCBC Skywalk, and Floral Fantasy for a truly immersive experience.





SKYPARK OBSERVATION DECK

Experience the SkyPark Observation Deck, Singapore's premier viewpoint located on the 57th floor of Marina Bay Sands. From this vantage point, enjoy a panoramic view of the entire city. At an elevation of 200 meters, marvel at sights such as Gardens By The Bay, Supertree Grove, Singapore Flyer, and the vast sea. Keep an eye out for iconic landmarks like the famous Merlion and the domed Esplanade monument that add to the city's charm.

SINGAPORE CABLE CAR

A unique method of reaching Sentosa, one of Singapore's islands, is via the cable car system. Beginning at Mount Faber, this journey is a popular tourist attraction. As you glide through the air, you'll be treated to a panoramic view of the city, capturing the lush forests, expansive sea, and contemporary skyscrapers. In addition to the Mount Faber Line, travelers have the option to ride the Sentosa Line, which exclusively traverses Sentosa Island and offers a fifteen-minute scenic route.


















Asian | €€€€ | Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner
