CIRCUIT ZANDVOORT



ABOUT THE CIRCUIT



Circuit Zandvoort, located in the dunes of North Holland, is an iconic race track with a rich history dating back to 1939. After a 35-year absence, Formula 1 returned to Zandvoort in 2021.

The circuit is known for its unique layout with fast corners, undulations, and elevation changes, surrounded by beautiful dunes. Fans come from far and wide to experience the races, especially the loyal following of Max Verstappen, known as the "Orange Army." As soon as the start lights go out, the stands turn orange in a sea of flags and smoke, creating a unique and unforgettable atmosphere.

At 4.259 kilometers in length, Circuit Zandvoort is one of the shorter circuits on the Formula 1 calendar. This results in a fast-paced race with lots of action, as drivers overtake more frequently and drive closer to each other. Despite its compact length, the circuit is anything but simple. The 14 corners, with elevation changes of up to 8.9 meters, challenge drivers to test their driving skills and the performance of their cars to the utmost.

HOW WAS THE RACE LAST YEAR?



THE RACE IN 2023



Max Verstappen spectacularly equaled Sebastian Vettel's record of nine consecutive race victories in 2023 with a win at the Dutch Grand Prix. The Red Bull driver raced to victory in the rain.



Fernando Alonso finished second – his first podium since the Canadian Grand Prix – while Pierre Gasly took P3 thanks to a five-second time penalty for Sergio Perez, who was penalized for speeding in the pit lane. The Grand Prix was one of the most remarkable of the year, with the rain playing a significant role.

In the final stages of the race, the weather once again became a factor as a downpour caused red flags shortly after Zhou Guanyu crashed into the barriers at Turn 1.

The race resumed with seven laps remaining, and Verstappen took the checkered flag in front of his home crowd.

USEFUL INFO

HOW TO GET TO TRACK

Have you booked separate hotel accommodations plus transfers with Race Experience? If so, transfers to the circuit are included. Additionally, Circuit Zandvoort is accessible only by public transportation.

By Train

The Dutch Grand Prix is easily reachable by train from all over the Netherlands and Belgium. From Zandvoort aan Zee station, it is approximately a 15-minute walk to the circuit.

- Purchase a Dutch Grand Prix Day Return ticket [here](#). This ticket allows travel from any train station in the Netherlands to Zandvoort and back. The ticket is valid for one day.

ENTRY GATES

To ensure quick access:

- Have your bag ready for inspection.
- There may be a queue while checking all fans. We appreciate your patience.
- We advise arriving well in advance to allow sufficient time for security checks.

OPENING HOURS

Circuit Zandvoort is open throughout the weekend from 08:00 to 21:00. Once you enter, re-entry is not permitted.

USEFUL INFO

SANITARY FACILITIES

There are sufficient (temporary) toilets available on the circuit. Look out for signs directing you to the nearest toilet. In general, the toilets are kept very clean. The toilets can be very busy during a Grand Prix weekend, especially right before a Formula 1 session.

FOOD & DRINKS

Circuit Zandvoort offers a diverse selection of food and beverages at the event grounds. You can choose from pancakes, poffertjes, burgers, sandwiches, fries, or other fried snacks. In Zandvoort, only card payments are accepted.

Unfortunately, it is not allowed to bring your own food and drinks. However, you may bring an empty plastic bottle to fill with water at the circuit. Free water refill stations are available at Circuit Zandvoort.

WALKING DISTANCE

During a Grand Prix weekend, expect plenty of walking. Hence, opt for comfortable shoes and attire to avoid blisters and discomfort. Pick clothing that allows easy movement, ensuring you can fully enjoy the event.

TAKING PICTURES

It is allowed to take photos on the circuit with a simple camera for personal use. Pay attention to others and avoid obstructing their view. Be respectful to fellow spectators.

WEATHER AND CLIMATE

During the Dutch Grand Prix at the end of August in Zandvoort, you can often expect variable weather. It can be sunny and warm, but it can also quickly change to rain and wind. Be prepared and bring a good poncho just in case.

FAN ZONE

Visit the F1 Fan Zone at the Zandvoort Circuit. Located behind the Arie Luyendijk corner, it features interactive activities, merchandise stands, and food outlets. The Fan Zone is a bustling hub where fans can enjoy entertainment and experience a sense of connection with the world of Formula 1.

ENTERTAINMENT & ACTIVITEITEN

On Friday, the Fan Zone welcomes top Dutch artists such as Xander de Buissonjé, Yves Berendse, Wolter Kroes, DI-RECT, and Armin van Buuren.
