So you might be planning to go to the Spanish Grand Prix and wonder which tickets you should get. Then this ticket tip guide might help. Here we will provide you with useful tips when selecting tickets for the Grand Prix.

Besides this, there is a short overview per grandstand to give you an idea of what the views are like with different ticket options. Good luck selecting your tickets and if there is anything you need help or support with, don't hesitate to reach out!







01. TICKET TIPS

To help you select the right tickets and get you well prepared for your trip to the Spanish Grand Prix, we have compiled a few ticket tips:

- **S**
- You will be able to sit together if you order tickets for the same grandstand and the same days in one order.

Seniors aged 65 and children aged 6-14 receive approximately 50% discount. This discount is on three-day grandstand tickets.

Children under 6 years old have free access to grandstands if they do not occupy a seat. Therefore, you must inform us of this in advance so we can secure this for you.

Tickets in most grandstands have zones, which correspond to row numbers.

All grandstands have access to large TV screens, so you won't mix any action.

If you travel to the circuit by car, you should order a parking ticket in advance. On site, you cannot buy parking tickets.

You can park for free when travelling by motorcycle.






02. GRANDSTAND TICKET TYPES

The tickets at the Spanish Grand Prix are divided into 5 categories:

- Excellence Grandstand
- Super Fan Grandstand
- Fan+ Grandstand
- Fan Grandstand
- General Admission

Below you will be able to find an overview of the different types of tickets which are available at the Spanish Grand Prix. Along with this you can find information on the views that the different tickets offer and if it is worth the price you pay for it.

EXCELLENCE GRANDSTANDS

This category includes the covered main grandstand, which normally accommodates about 10,000 spectators. Moreover, it offers a view of the start/finish straight and pit lane.

Stand F also falls into this category. This is an excellent premium grandstand choice in Montmelo. This stand is located at the end of the straight next to the pit lane. Hence, you will have a panoramic view of the track's complex of turns.

Additionally, Stand T1 and Stand A are also part of the Excellence category. You can find these stands at the end of the straight, offering a view of turns 1, 2, and the entrance to turn 3.

Finally, Stand T10 is in the Excellence category, providing a view of turns 10, 11, and 12.

SUPERFAN GRANDSTANDS

This classification encompasses four grandstands with great visibility. Firstly, you can find Grandstand N before turn 9. It captures the fast and sharp maneuvers of the drivers, ensuring plenty of action.

Another Superfan grandstand is Grandstand H. This grandstand offers a view of the final bend where cars enter the straight. It will provide a comprehensive perspective on the final moments of a lap.

Lastly, Superfan stands Grandstand L and Grandstand M provide good viewpoints. Grandstand L affords views of turns 1, 2, 5, and 6. This offers a comprehensive overview of the track's starting section. Grandstand M, positioned at turn 5, will give you a view of a fast yet tight bend. Grandstand S is located next to Grandstand N and offers a view of turn 9. Besides this, it is covered and offers a view of multiple tv screens.

FAN+ GRANDSTANDS

Looking for an intermediate category between the Excellence Grandstands and Fan Grandstands? Then, the Fan+ Grandstand offers great value for money. But be aware, it might not provide the absolute best vantage point.

Grandstands G and C fall into this category. They are situated in the stadium section, at the lap's end before the entry straight. Notably, Grandstand G, the largest stand, is particularly popular among Dutch fans. Therefore, it is often recognized as the Orange stand.

Finally, Grandstand E, similar in location to Grandstand F, offers a slightly less optimal view of the track's initial corner complex.

FAN GRANDSTANDS

This category includes the more economical Grandstand J and Grandstand K. They are both located on the straight next to the main grandstand, leading towards Turn 1. From here, you can experience the race start. You will witness which driver gains the upper hand off the starting line.

GENERAL ADMISSION

General Admission tickets are the most affordable tickets for an F1 weekend. The areas we recommend are located on the outside of turn 3. Another place is the inside of turn 4 Or you can take a seat near turn 6 or 7. At the latter, you even have a view of a TV screen so you don't miss any of the race action.
