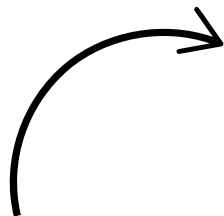

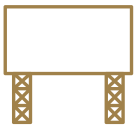
To help you select the right tickets and be prepared for your trip to the Grand Prix of China, we have a few ticket tips for you:



Are you ordering tickets for the same grandstand and the same day in a single purchase? Then you are guaranteed to sit together during the Formula 1 in China.



Child discounts are available for the age category 2–16 years. Please note: the discount is only valid if your child is 16 years old or younger at the time of the Chinese Grand Prix. You can select the desired child tickets in the “Child Tickets 2–16 years” ticket category.



Most of the grandstands on the circuit have access to at least one big screen. This ensures that you won't miss any of the action on track.



The view from the grandstands in China is generally limited to one or two corners. Some grandstands have an exclusive ‘premium’ section at the top. This area is covered and offers a better, panoramic view of the track. In addition, the roof provides some protection from the weather.

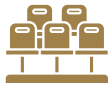


# Grandstand Ticket Options

On the following pages, you will find an overview of the different grandstands available at the Shanghai International Circuit in China. For each grandstand, we provide information about the view and what parts of the circuit you can follow, so you can get a clear idea of what to expect and choose the option that suits you best.

## Grandstands

### Main Grandstand

The Main Grandstand is the primary grandstand at the China circuit and is divided into three zones: Platinum, High, and Low. The Platinum section is located in the middle of the Main Grandstand and provides access to the exclusive Platinum Lounge. The High section offers a panoramic view of the start/finish area and the pit boxes, as well as a good view of Turn 1. The Low section is the lowest part of the Main Grandstand and provides good visibility of the start/finish area and the pit lane.

### Grandstand B

Grandstand B is located at the end of the straight. From here, you have a view of the action from Turns 1 to 6. In addition, you can also see the starting grid and the finish line.

### Grandstand H

Grandstand H is located just before Turn 14, at the end of the circuit's long straight. From this grandstand, you get an excellent view of Turns 14, 15, and 16. Grandstand H is covered, providing an extra element of comfort.

## Grandstand K

Grandstand K is located between Turns 15 and the final Turn 16. Here, you can see the drivers accelerate after exiting Turn 14 and brake for Turn 16. It is situated opposite Grandstand H.

## General Admission

General Admission tickets provide access to one of the zones around the circuit: C, F, J, or L. There are no assigned seats in these areas, so it's recommended to arrive early to secure the best spots. The General Admission areas are grassy banks, so it's advisable to bring something to sit on.

From Zone C, you can see the cars coming out of Turn 5 and heading into the sharp Turn 6. The General Admission area F is located along the longest straight of the circuit, closer to Turn 13, where you can watch the cars exit this long sweeping corner. The third General Admission zone, Zone J, is situated around the outside of the hairpin at Turn 14, giving you a good view of this corner.
