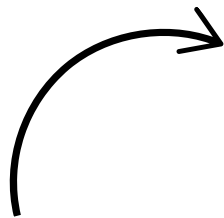

Grandstand ticket options

Are you planning to attend the Grand Prix of Monza and unsure which tickets suit you best? In this ticket guide, you will find practical tips to help you make the right choice. We briefly explain the differences between the ticket options and what to look out for.

Ticket Tips

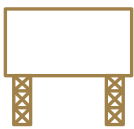
To help you select the right tickets and be prepared for your trip to the Grand Prix of Italy, we have a few ticket tips for you:



Are you ordering tickets for the same grandstand and the same day in a single purchase? Then you are guaranteed to sit together during the Formula 1 in Monza.



Child discounts are available for the 2-14 age group. Please note: the discount is only valid if your child is 14 years old or younger at the time of the Italian Grand Prix. You can select the desired child tickets in the “Child Tickets 2-14 years” category.



Most of the grandstands on the circuit have access to at least one big screen. This ensures that you won't miss any of the action on track.



The view from the grandstands in Monza is generally limited to one or two corners. Some grandstands in Monza are stacked on top of each other, with the higher tiers offering a better view than the lower ones.





Grandstands

Grandstand 1

Grandstand 1, also known as Centrale 1, is the main grandstand at the Monza circuit. From this grandstand, you have an excellent view of the start and finish area. It also offers good visibility of the pit lane. In addition, this location provides a view of one of the most unique podiums on the Formula 1 calendar. The grandstand is also covered, providing extra comfort during the race weekend.

Grandstand 2/3

Grandstands 2 and 3, also known as Laterale Sinistra 2 and 3, are two adjacent grandstands located at the start and finish area of the Monza circuit. From these grandstands, you have a good view of the start and finish line as well as the pit garages of the top Formula 1 teams.

Grandstand 4

Grandstand Laterale Sinistra 4 is located above Grandstands 2 and 3. From this grandstand, you have a good view of the start and finish area and the pit lane. Thanks to its higher position, this grandstand offers a broader view of the start and finish section compared to Grandstands 2 and 3.

Grandstand 5

Grandstand 5, also known as Piscina 5, is located at the start and finish area of the Monza circuit, next to Grandstand 3. From this grandstand, you have a view of the end of the pit lane and part of the start and finish area. From this location, you do not have a view of the first corners, as this view is obstructed.

Grandstand 7

Grandstand 7, also known as Biassono 7, is located along the main straight of the Monza circuit. From this grandstand, you have a good view of the exit of the pit lane. Although there are no grandstands to the left of this location, you do not have a view of corners 1 and 2 due to the iconic VIP tower at Monza.

Grandstand 25

Grandstand 25, also known as Uscita Parabolica 25, is located at the beginning of the main straight at the Monza circuit. From this grandstand, you have a good view of the exit of the iconic Parabolica corner.

Grandstand 26 A/B/C

Grandstands 26 A/B/C, also known as Laterale Destra, are located along the main straight of the Monza circuit. From these grandstands, you have a view of part of corner 11 (Parabolica) and a large section of the start and finish area. In addition, you have a good view of the iconic Monza podium. These grandstands are among the most expensive at the circuit. All seats are covered.

Grandstand 27/28

Grandstands 27 and 28, also known as Gradinate Traguardo, are the two leftmost, lower level grandstands located beneath Grandstand 26. From these grandstands, you have a good view of the start and finish area and the pit lane. However, due to the difference in elevation, the overall view is more limited compared to Grandstand 26.

Grandstand 29/30

Grandstands 29/30, also known as Gradinate Traguardo, are located to the lower right of Grandstand 26. From these grandstands, you have a good view of the start and finish area and the podium. In addition, you also have a good view of part of the pit lane.

Grandstand 24

Grandstand 24, also known as Vedano 24, is the first grandstand located at the start and finish area of the Monza circuit. From this grandstand, you have a good view of the cars exiting corner 11 (Parabolica). In addition, it offers good visibility of the pit lane entry and the beginning of the start and finish straight. This grandstand is also covered.

Grandstand 35 A/B/C

Grandstand 35, also known as Vedano A/B/C, is located beneath Grandstand 24. From this grandstand, you have a good view of the beginning of the start and finish area and the exit of the Parabolica corner (corner 11). However, visibility is more limited compared to Grandstand 24 due to the difference in elevation.

Grandstand 23 A/B

Grandstands 23 A/B, also known as Parabolica Interna, are located on the inside of the Monza circuit. From this grandstand, you have a good view of the pit lane entry and the beginning of corner 11.

Grandstand 6 A/B/C

Grandstand 6, also known as Alta Velocità, is located on the inside of the Monza circuit. The grandstand is divided into three sections: 6A, 6B, and 6C.

Grandstand 6A offers a good view of part of the start and finish area and corner 1. Grandstand 6B provides a good view of the iconic first two corners of Monza, with only limited visibility of a small part of the start and finish straight.

Grandstand 6C offers an excellent view of corners 1 and 2, as well as a good view of the first section of the Curva Grande, the long sweeping corner 3.

Grandstand 8 A/B

Grandstands 8A/8B, also known as Prima Variante Esterna A, are located on the outside of corner 1. From these grandstands, you have a good view of corners 1 and 2. Grandstand 8B is the lower section, bringing you closer to the action.

Grandstand 8A is higher, offering a broader overview of the first two corners.

Grandstand 9

Grandstand 9, also known as Roggia 9, is located at corner 4 of the Monza circuit. From this grandstand, you have a clear view of corners 4 and 5, where heavy braking and close racing action often take place. This is a relatively small grandstand, which means it tends to sell out quickly.

Grandstand 10

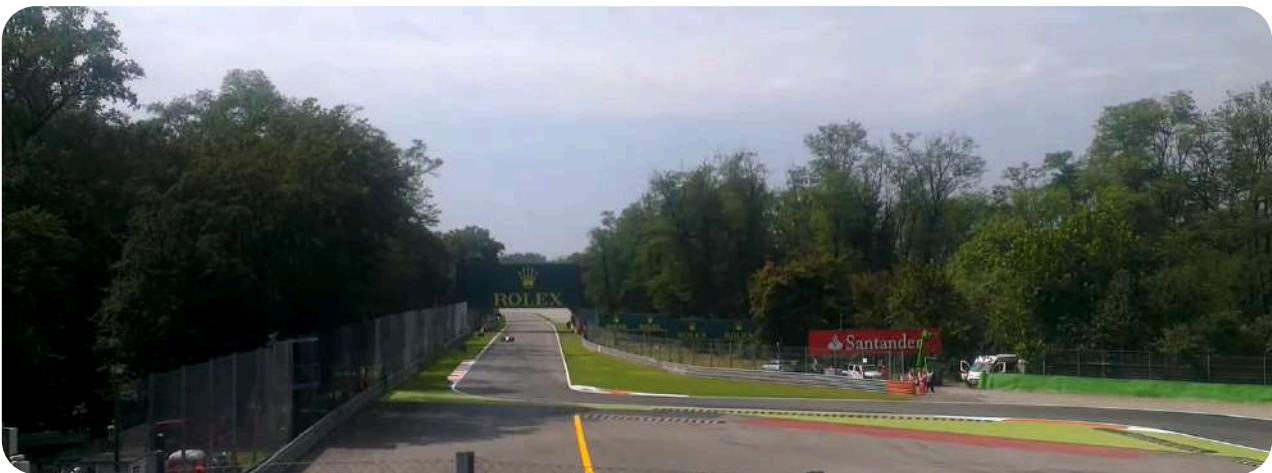
Grandstand 10, also known as Roggia 10, is located at corner 5 of the Monza circuit. From this grandstand, you have a good view of corners 4 and 5. This is a relatively small grandstand, which means it typically sells out quickly.

Grandstand 33 A/B

Grandstands 33A/B, also known as Seconde Variante, are located before corner 4 of the Monza circuit. From this grandstand, you have a good view of the entry into corner 4, where many overtaking attempts take place. Grandstand 33A is the first of the two Seconde Variante grandstands. From Grandstand 33B, you also have a partial view of corner 5.

Grandstand 34

Grandstand 34, also known as Lesmo 1 Esterna, is a new grandstand located on the outside of corner 6 of the Monza circuit. From this grandstand, you have a view of corner 6 and the exit of corner 5.

Grandstand 10 Bis

Grandstand 10 Bis, also known as Lesmo 2 Interno, is located on the inside of corner 7 of the Monza circuit. From this grandstand, you have a good view of corner 7, one of the two famous Lesmo corners. In addition, you also have visibility of part of the straight between corners 7 and 8.

Grandstand 11

Grandstand 11, also known as Serraglio 11, is located on the straight between corners 7 and 8 of the Monza circuit. From this grandstand, you have a view of this straight section. This is one of the most remote grandstands at the circuit.

Grandstand 13

Grandstand 13, also known as Ascari 4, is the first grandstand in the Ascari section of the Monza circuit. From this grandstand, you have a good view of corners 8, 9, and 10. It is located on the inside of the circuit, offering a clear overview of the full Ascari chicane.

Grandstand 12

Grandstand 12, also known as Ascari 3, is located directly next to Grandstand 13. From this grandstand, you have a clear view of the full Ascari chicane (corners 8, 9, and 10).

Grandstand 15

Grandstand 15, also known as Ascari 15, is located at corner 10 of the Monza circuit. From this grandstand, you have a clear view of the entire Ascari chicane (corners 8, 9, and 10). It is located on the inside of the circuit.

Grandstand 16

Grandstand 16, also known as Ascari 16, is located next to corner 10 on the inside of the Monza circuit. From this grandstand, you have a clear view of the full Ascari chicane (corners 8, 9, and 10).

Grandstand 18

Grandstand 18, also known as Uscita Ascari A, is located on the straight between corners 10 and 11 of the Monza circuit. From this grandstand, you have a good view of corners 9 and 10, as well as the cars accelerating towards the final corner of the circuit: the Parabolica. This grandstand is covered, providing extra comfort.

Grandstand 17A/17B

Grandstands 17A and 17B, also known as Ascari Esterna A/B, are located on the outside of the circuit at corner 10 of Monza. From these grandstands, you have a clear view of the full Ascari chicane (corners 8, 9, and 10). Grandstand 17A is the left stand of the two and offers a closer view of the action, providing a more intense experience of the Ascari chicane compared to Grandstand 17B.

Grandstand 21E

Grandstand 21E is the first grandstand in the Parabolica section. From this grandstand, you have an unobstructed view on the right side, as there are no adjacent grandstands on the right, unlike the other Parabolica stands. From here, you have a clear view of the entire straight between corners 10 and 11.

Grandstand 21 D/C

Grandstands 21C and 21D in the Parabolica section are two of the central grandstands. From these grandstands, you have a good view of a large part of the straight between corners 10 and 11. In addition, you also have a view of the cars entering the Parabolica corner.

Grandstand 21 A/B

Grandstands 21A and 21B are also two of the central grandstands in the Parabolica section. These stands are located on the right-hand side, offering a good view of a large part of the Parabolica corner.

Grandstand 22

Grandstand 22 is widely considered the best grandstand in the Parabolica section. It is located at the apex of corner 11. From this grandstand, you have an excellent view of almost the entire iconic Parabolica corner. Grandstand 22 is also one of the few covered grandstands at the Monza circuit.

Grandstand GF

Grandstand GF is located on the inside of corner 11 (Parabolica) at the Monza circuit. From this grandstand, you have a good view of the Parabolica corner, although you are positioned very close to the track, which limits the overall overview of corner 11.

General Admission

The General Admission areas at Monza offer various zones and opportunities where visitors can watch the race. General Admission tickets are among the most affordable options for the Italian Grand Prix. It is recommended to arrive early, as the best viewing spots tend to fill up quickly. Below you will find the different General Admission zones.

Next to Grandstand 7 up to corner 1, there is a large General Admission area. From this location, you have a good view of the cars exiting the pit lane, as well as part of the start and finish straight.

Between corner 2 and Grandstand 33A, on the inside of the circuit, there is also a large General Admission area. From here, you have a clear view of the Curva Grande, one of the fastest corners on the Formula 1 calendar.

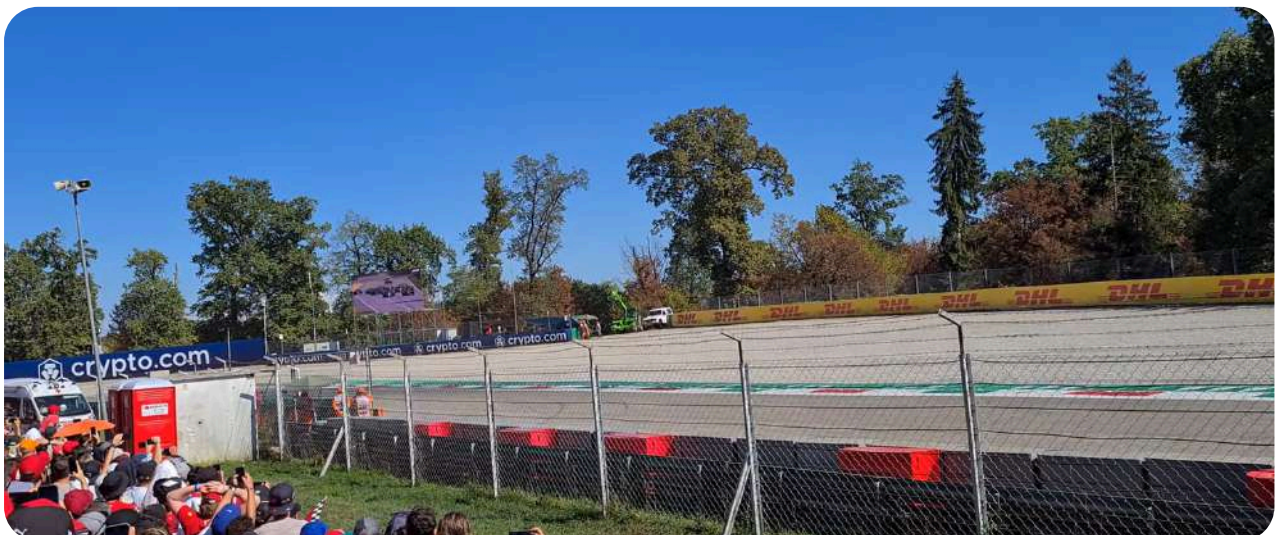
Due to the size of this area, it generally fills up less quickly.

On the inside of corners 6 and 7, there is another General Admission zone with a good view of the two iconic Lesmo corners. This location is popular and tends to fill up quickly due to its limited capacity and strong viewing position.

On the straight between corners 7 and 8, there is also a General Admission area. From here, you do not have a view of any corners, but you can see the straight leading towards the Ascari chicane.

Between Grandstand 17B and Grandstand 21E (Parabolica), there is a General Admission area located on a hill. From this point, you have a good overview of a large section of the straight between corners 10 and 11.

Finally, there is a General Admission area on the inside of the Parabolica corner. This zone is relatively large and offers multiple viewing angles, including the entry and exit of the Parabolica corner, as well as a view towards the beginning of the start and finish straight.
