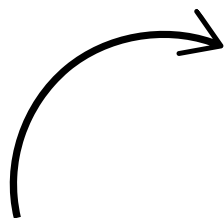

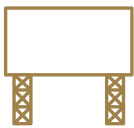
To help you select the right tickets and be prepared for your trip to the Grand Prix of in Zandvoort, we have a few ticket tips for you:



Are you ordering tickets for the same grandstand and the same day in a single purchase? Then you are guaranteed to sit together during the Formula 1 in the Netherlands.



There are unfortunately no tickets with a discount available for children at this circuit.



Most of the grandstands on the circuit have access to at least one big screen. This ensures that you won't miss any of the action on track.



If you've got General Admission tickets for the Grand Prix in Zandvoort, make sure you arrive in time to secure a good spot for the race.



2026 will be the final edition of the Dutch Grand Prix. Which means that for now, this will be your final chance to attend the race in the Netherlands.

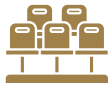


# Grandstand Ticket Options

On the following pages, you will find an overview of the different grandstands available at the Zandvoort Circuit in the Netherlands. For each grandstand, we provide information about the view and what parts of the circuit you can follow, so you can get a clear idea of what to expect and choose the option that suits you best.

## Grandstands

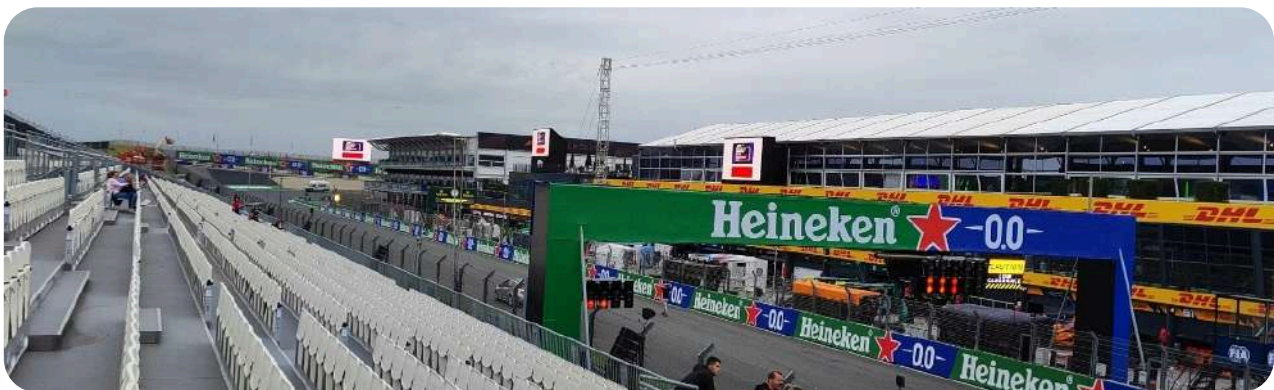
### Ben Pon 1 / 2 Grandstand

Along the straights of the circuit, the Ben Pon Tribune is the first grandstand along this section. Here, you can enjoy an excellent view of the entrance to the pit lane and the pit lane itself. This grandstand is one of the more expensive options at the Zandvoort circuit.

You can choose between Ben Pon 1, which is a Gold grandstand, and Ben Pon 2, which is a Silver grandstand. The Gold seats are slightly higher, offering a somewhat better view, but they are also more expensive.

### The Main Grandstand

The Main Grandstand is the best option if you wish to have a covered seat and a great view on the straight of Zandvoort. From this grandstand you can see the build-up for the race and see the start from up close. Besides this you will be able to see into the pitlane, allowing you to follow pitstops live. This Grandstand is one of the more expensive options on the circuit.

### The Pit Grandstand

The Pit Tribune offers an ideal view of the pit lane and the straight where the cars race by at full speed. In addition, you can follow the live strategies of the top teams from the grandstand. You also get a fantastic view of the race start. This grandstand is one of the most expensive at the Zandvoort circuit.

## Tarzan in Grandstand

Located at Turn 1 of the Zandvoort circuit, the Tarzan In Tribune offers a panoramic view of Turn 1. Overtaking maneuvers often occur at this corner, as the drivers come off the straight and have to brake hard for the first turn. The Tarzan In Tribune offers excellent value for the view it provides, especially considering the price.

## Eastside 3 Grandstand

The best locations are at the entrance of the chicane: in Sector 3. You can enjoy an excellent view of this tight and challenging corner. This corner is promising for overtaking due to the straights leading into the braking zone.

Since Eastside 3 is closest to the Arena section, it is the tallest of the three Eastside grandstands, but it offers excellent value for the price and the view you get.

## Arena 1 Grandstand

Arena 1 is one of the best spots at the Zandvoort circuit. The grandstand is located at Turn 12. The atmosphere here is fantastic, and you also get a great view of one of the most beautiful parts of the circuit, which demands both speed and technical skill from the drivers.

## **Eastside 2A / 2B Grandstand**

You'll find Eastside 2A/2B between Eastside 1 and 3. This grandstand offers a decent view of Turn 11, where the drivers will have to brake hard after a long straight before navigating the technical Turn 12. It is one of the more affordable grandstands at Zandvoort. Even though it is slightly farther from the Arena grandstands, you can still enjoy plenty of the atmosphere from Eastside 2A/2B.

## **Arena-in 1 / 2 Grandstand**

These grandstands offer excellent views and provide a perspective similar to Eastside 3. This means you get a good view of how the drivers brake hard to dive into the Arena section. However, the view is slightly less extensive. The Arena-In 1 / 2 grandstand is still considered the best Silver grandstand at Zandvoort.

## **Eastside 1 Grandstand**

The Eastside 1 grandstand is located in the middle of one of the straights of the Zandvoort circuit. It offers a view of the cars exiting Turn 10 and braking for Turn 11. In addition, you can see overtaking maneuvers leading into Turn 11. The Eastside 1 Tribune offers good value for money for the view you get.

## Eastside 4 Grandstand

The Eastside 4 grandstand is located opposite the Arena 3 grandstand. It offers a decent view of the cars exiting the Arena section and heading towards Turn 13, one of the final corners of the circuit. This grandstand is one of the more affordable options at the Zandvoort circuit.

## Arena-Out Grandstand

This grandstand is located just before the last two corners of the circuit, also known as the “curve.” From this grandstand, you will see the cars approaching at high speed as they lightly brake before entering the bowl corner. Although overtaking maneuvers may not happen directly in front of you, it is still a great grandstand to experience the final moments of a lap.

## Hairpin 1 / 2 Grandstand

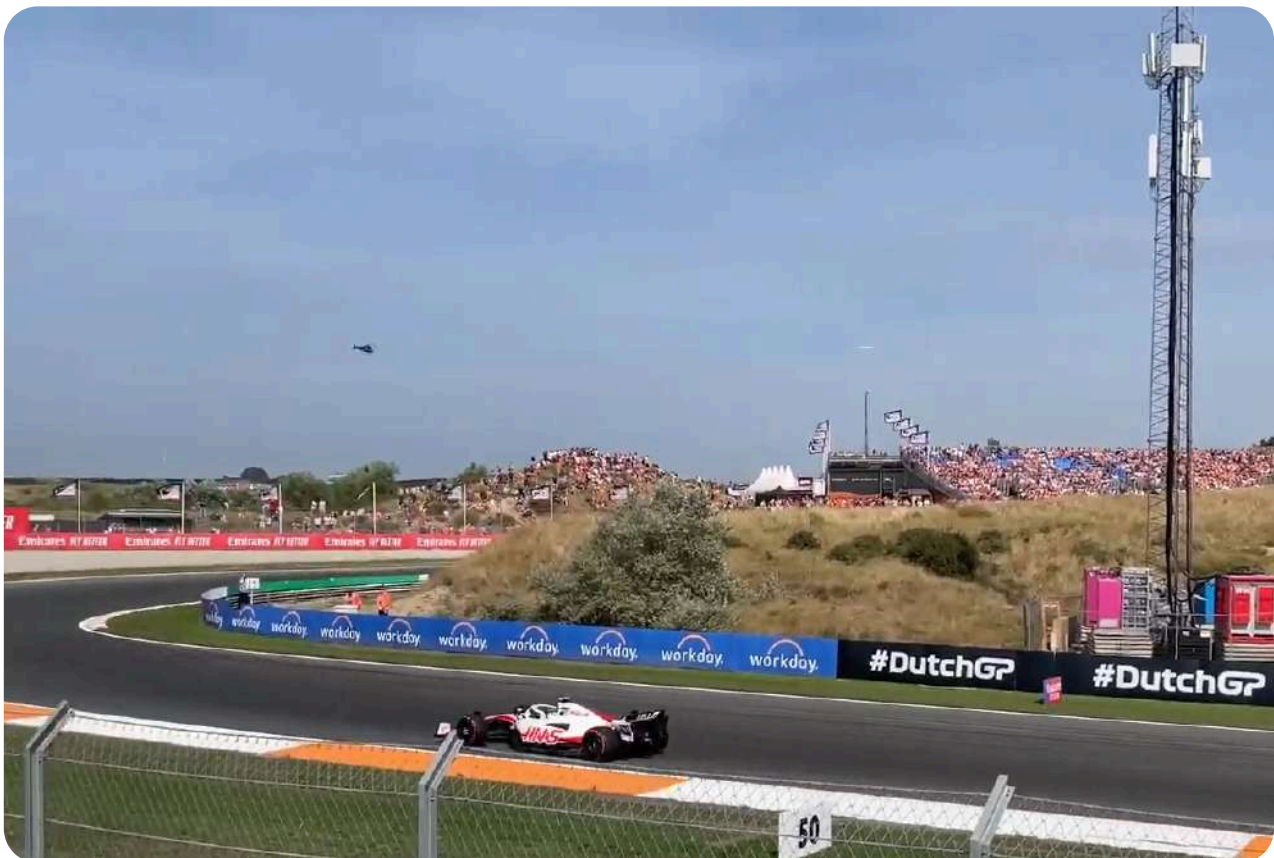
Located at the hairpin of Turn 10, you can see the cars pass relatively slowly. Bronze Hairpin Tribune 1 is on the right side of Turn 10. This provides a view of the cars exiting Turn 9 and driving directly past you.

On the left side of Turn 10, Bronze Hairpin Tribune 2 offers a view of the straights leading into Turn 11. Overall, the Bronze Hairpin Tribunes are the most affordable grandstands at the Zandvoort circuit.

## General Admission

The most affordable way to enjoy the Dutch Grand Prix is with General Admission tickets. With these tickets, you can move freely within the General Admission zones, but you do not have an assigned seat. You need to arrive at the circuit relatively early before the sessions start to secure a good spot, and it can get quite crowded. Nevertheless, these tickets still allow you to experience some of the action and soak in the atmosphere of the Grand Prix at Zandvoort.

There are two General Admission zones at Zandvoort. If you only have tickets for General Admission Zone 1, you do not have access to the second zone, and vice versa. The prices for both zones are roughly the same, but tickets for General Admission 1 give you access to a larger area.
