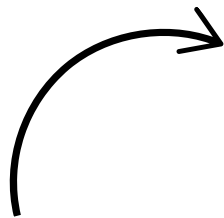

Grandstand ticket options

Are you planning to attend the Grand Prix of Belgium and unsure which tickets suit you best? In this ticket guide, you will find practical tips to help you make the right choice. We briefly explain the differences between the ticket options and what to look out for.

Ticket Tips

To help you select the right tickets and be prepared for your trip to the Grand Prix of Belgium, we have a few ticket tips for you:



Are you ordering tickets for the same grandstand and the same day in a single purchase? Then you are guaranteed to sit together during the Formula 1 in Belgium.



Grandstand tickets for children (6–12 years) are approximately 50% cheaper than regular three-day ticket prices.



All Gold and Silver grandstands offer views with a large TV screen. There are also a number of TV screens in the General Admission areas, specifically on the Kemmel Straight and at Pouhon.



A special grandstand for fans with limited mobility is located next to the Gold 7 grandstand at La Source and at Gold 11 at the Chicane.

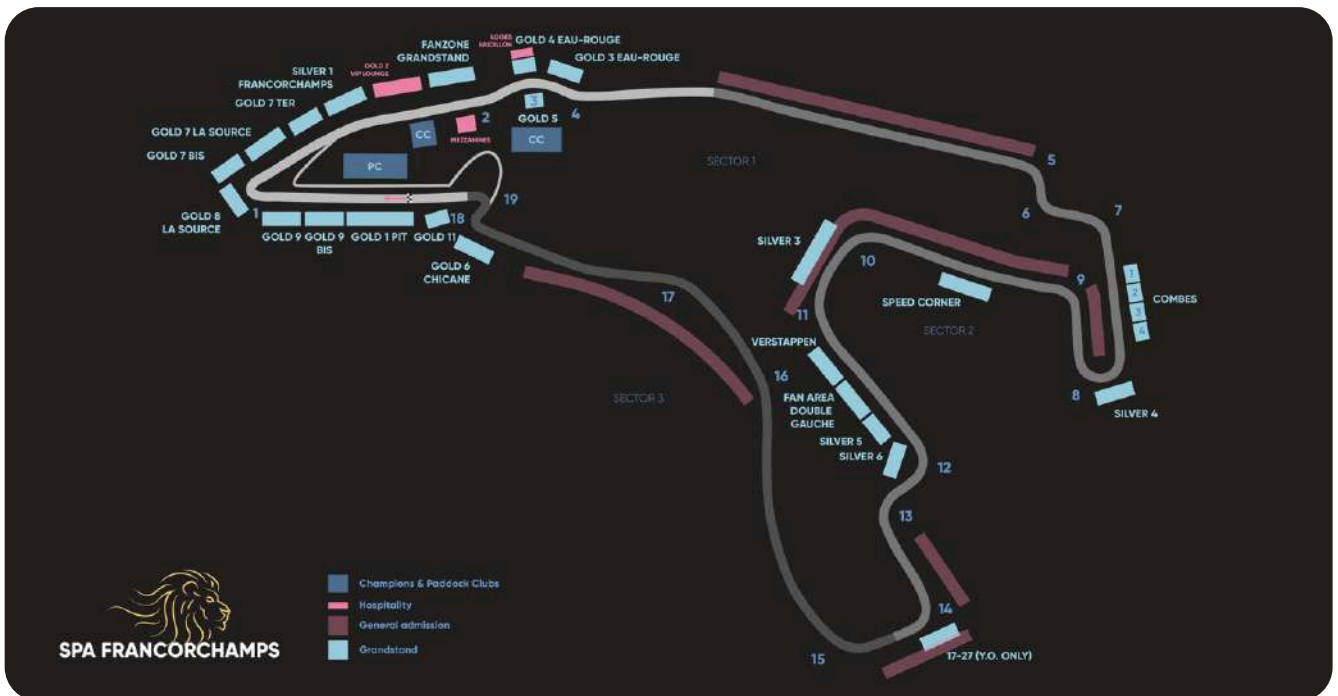


Sunday tickets (one day) are available for all grandstands and General Admission. During early sales, three-day tickets are often cheaper than Sunday tickets.

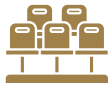


Grandstand Ticket Options

On the following pages, you will find an overview of the different grandstands available at the circuit de Spa-Francorchamps in Belgium. For each grandstand, we provide information about the view and what parts of the circuit you can follow, so you can get a clear idea of what to expect and choose the option that suits you best.

Grandstands

Gold 1 Grandstand

Gold 1 is the main grandstand opposite the pit lane on the straight at the start/finish line. It is a good choice for watching the race start/finish, the action in the pit lane, and the podium celebrations after the race. However, if you are looking for on-track action, it is recommended to choose a different grandstand. This grandstand is covered, but you may get a little wet in the lower rows when it rains.

Gold 2 Grandstand

Gold 2 is a large, elevated grandstand. It is located on the straight between La Source and Eau Rouge. From here, you can see the old pit lane, which is still used for support races during the Belgian Grand Prix weekend.

You can see Eau Rouge in the distance, but there are better views available for this price.

Fanzone Grandstand

The Fanzone Grandstand is the best place to see Eau Rouge and Raidillon. It offers a fantastic view of the famous corner and the section of the circuit leading up to it.

However, a certain level of physical fitness is required to reach this grandstand from La Source, as it is located on a fairly steep hill. Nevertheless, we recommend this grandstand, as it provides an incredible view.

Gold 3 Grandstand

In our opinion, the Gold 3 Grandstand is one of the best grandstands at this circuit. You get a beautiful panoramic view of the cars storming out of Turn 1 through Eau Rouge, one of the most iconic corners in Formula 1.

In addition to the great view, you can also see the cars exiting the pits. The Gold 3 Grandstand is covered.

Gold 4 Grandstand

Gold 4 is an uncovered grandstand next to Eau Rouge. However, it is located quite far from the track and has an awkward angle, which limits the view. Instead, you might consider paying a little more for the Fanzone Grandstand, as it offers better value for your money.

Gold 5 Grandstand

The Gold 5 Grandstand is located on the inside of the circuit, opposite the Gold 4 Grandstand. From here, you also have a good view of Eau Rouge, although it is better seen from one of the grandstands on the outside of the circuit. This grandstand is not covered.

Gold 6 Grandstand

Gold 6 is a small, covered grandstand on the outside of the Bus Stop Chicane, the final corners of the circuit, and close to the pit lane entrance. From this grandstand, you can see the cars coming out of the fast Blanchimont corner and braking hard for the technical chicane. It is one of the more expensive grandstands, but you can often expect on-track action at this part of the circuit, so it is definitely worth it!

Gold 7 Grandstand

You can find Gold 7 at the exit of the La Source (Turn 1) hairpin. From this grandstand, you can see the cars coming out of the first corner and heading toward Eau Rouge. Gold 7 consists of three grandstands: Gold 7 Ter, Gold 7, and Gold 7 Bis. Of the three, Gold 7 Bis is closest to La Source. While Gold 7 still offers a decent view, we prefer Gold 8. Gold 7 is covered, whereas Gold 7 Ter and Gold 7 Bis are not.

Grandstand 8 Grandstand

Gold 8 is located at the La Source hairpin (Turn 1) and offers a view of the start/finish line. The popularity of this grandstand is clear, as it is often the first to sell out. The view is fantastic, and if tickets are available, we recommend buying them as soon as possible. From here, you can see the start/finish line and watch the cars exit the La Source corner. The grandstand is covered.

Gold 9 Grandstand

Gold 9 is a smaller, temporary grandstand closer to the opening La Source corner on the start/finish straight. It is located opposite the pit boxes of the slower teams. You can see La Source in the distance, providing a fairly good view of the action during the first lap of a race. Next to Gold 9 is Gold 9 Bis. The difference is that from 9 Bis, the view of Turn 1 is more limited, but it is slightly cheaper.

Gold 11 Grandstand

Gold 11 is located close to the final corner of the Spa circuit and offers a beautiful view of the Main Straight. From this grandstand, you can also see the Bus Stop Chicane. A large TV screen is available so you can follow all the race action. However, it is worth noting that Gold 11 is one of the more expensive options at the Spa circuit. The Gold 11 Grandstand is covered.

Silver 1 Grandstand

The Silver 1 Grandstand is located on the section of the circuit between La Source and Eau Rouge. From this grandstand, you get a good view of the stretch between these two corners and can see the cars exit La Source and go through Eau Rouge. You still have an individually numbered seat in the Silver 1 Grandstand, but these are bleacher-style seats. They also do not have backrests to lean against, which can make them slightly less comfortable than other grandstands. Keep in mind that the fence at the bottom of the grandstand limits the view from the lower rows. The Silver 1 Grandstand is not covered.

Silver 3 Grandstand

Silver 3 is located near Turn 10, Pouhon, on the inside of the circuit. The grandstand offers a nice view of a beautiful corner combination. In our opinion, it is a less spectacular grandstand than Silver 1 in terms of sightlines, but it does provide more comfort, as this grandstand has backrests. You can still occasionally see overtaking maneuvers or a car running wide while speeding through the corner. Additionally, the atmosphere is enhanced by the many General Admission areas near the grandstand. The Silver 3 Grandstand is covered.

Silver 4 Grandstand

Silver 4 is located on the south side of the circuit, far from the other grandstands (and also far from the Fanzone). It offers a view of the slow Bruxelles corner (Turn 8), but this is much better seen from the General Admission area on the inside of the corner.

Silver 4 does have individual seats with backrests (like the Gold grandstands). However, the fences at the bottom of the grandstand also limit the view from the lower rows.

Silver 5 Grandstand

Silver 5 is located at the exit of the Pouhon corner. From here, you can see the cars coming out of this corner before entering Turn 13, Fagnes. The grandstand is next to Silver 6, and in terms of view, Silver 6 is slightly more interesting. The seats have backrests and are numbered, but the grandstand is not covered.

Silver 6 Grandstand

Silver 6 is positioned at the Fagnes corner, close to the Max Verstappen grandstand. You have an excellent view of Turns 12 and 13, which are known for their high speed. You can follow the race action on a large TV screen, ensuring you don't miss any of the action at the Spa circuit. Silver 6 stands out as one of the more affordable grandstands in Belgium and is not covered.

Speed Corner Grandstand

The Speed Corner Grandstand is located between Turns 9 and 10. From here, you can see the cars accelerate from Turn 9 toward Pouhon (Turn 10). This grandstand is one of the most affordable options at the Spa circuit and is not covered.

Combes Grandstand

The Les Combes Grandstand is located just after Turn 7 and offers a view of the cars approaching Turn 8. This grandstand might be a good choice if you are staying at the campsites.

17-27 Blanchimont Grandstand

This grandstand is accessible to visitors aged 17 to 27. It is located near Turn 14, just before Blanchimont, the long straight at the end of the circuit. The prices for this grandstand are among the most affordable options in Belgium, but it is not covered.

General Admission

Spa-Francorchamps has some of the best General Admission areas of any current F1 circuit. It is the longest race track on the calendar and is located in the heart of the Ardennes.

You do need to be reasonably fit to fully enjoy the beautiful natural surroundings. Many of the walking paths are unpaved, and for the best panoramic views, you will need to climb steep hills, especially around Eau Rouge. Wear comfortable shoes, and if it rains, a pair of boots will come in handy.
