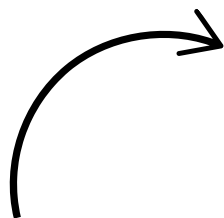

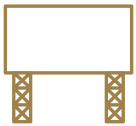
To help you select the right tickets and be prepared for your trip to the Grand Prix of Brazil, we have a few ticket tips for you:



Are you ordering tickets for the same grandstand and the same day in a single purchase? Then you are guaranteed to sit together during the Formula 1 in São Paulo.



No child discounts are available. Children aged 5 to 12 can only access the circuit when accompanied by an adult. Please note: children must also have their own ticket. Children under 5 years old are not allowed on the circuit.



Most of the grandstands on the circuit have access to at least one big screen. This ensures that you won't miss any of the action on track.



There are plenty of food and drink options at the circuit. A special card is used for purchases at the circuit, which can be obtained on-site.

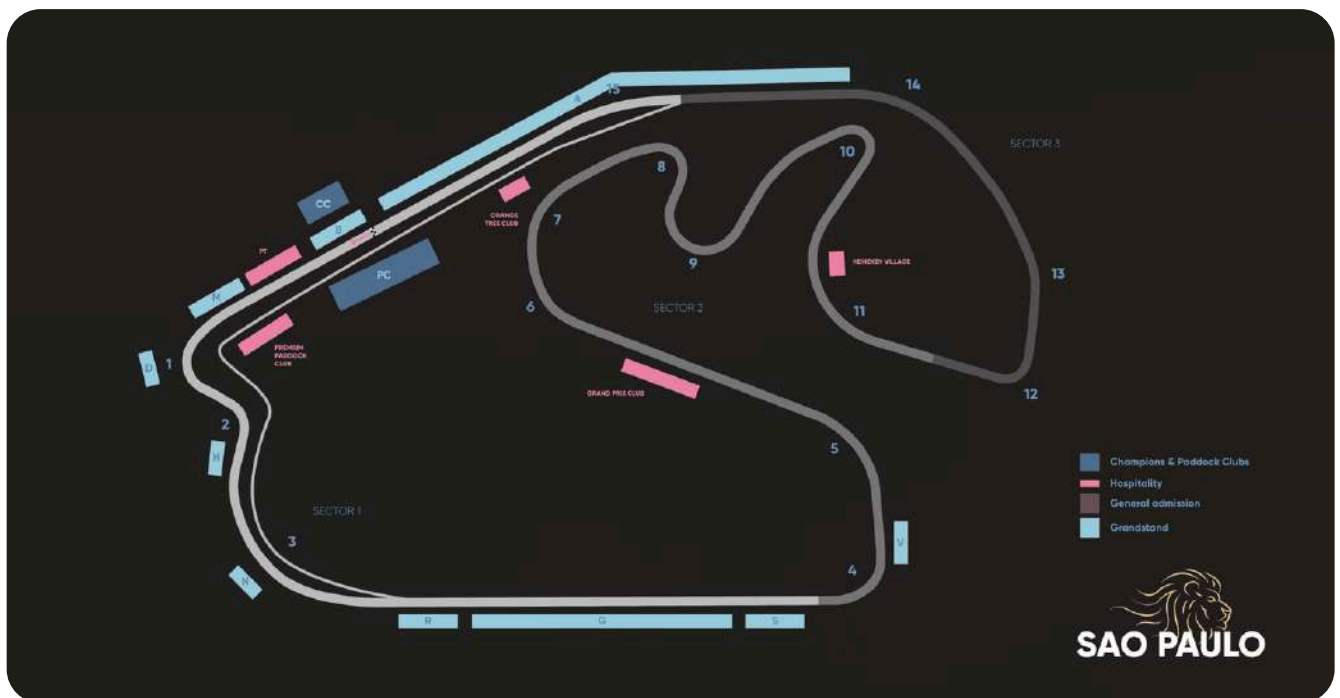


Please note that the grandstands at the Brazilian circuit, with the exception of Grandstands B & M, do not have reserved seating.

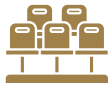


Grandstand Ticket Options

On the following pages, you will find an overview of the different grandstands available at the Interlagos Circuit in Brazil. For each grandstand, we provide information about the view and what parts of the circuit you can follow, so you can get a clear idea of what to expect and choose the option that suits you best.

Grandstands

Grandstand G

The cheapest grandstand is Grandstand G. It's a good option for those on a relatively small budget. You have a view of the straight between Turns 3 and 4, a spot where a lot of overtaking happens. It's a great choice to experience the Grand Prix among passionate Brazilian fans.

Grandstand A

This is a great grandstand with a good view of Turns 14 and 15 of the circuit. The value for money of this grandstand is very good. From here, you can see the cars coming out of the final corners and racing toward the finish. That's why this is the best choice if you have a limited budget!

Grandstand M

Grandstand M is located at the end of the straight. From this grandstand, you have a good view of the pit lane and start/finish line. You can also expect plenty of overtaking action in the Senna S. In our opinion, this grandstand is the best choice if you have a bit more to spend.

Grandstand B

Grandstand B is also located along the straight at the start/finish. It is relatively expensive, but the view is exceptional. This grandstand remains a great choice for a first-class view of the start/finish and pit stops.

If you want to see the start/finish and pit stops exceptionally well, this is a good option. For more on-track action, however, we recommend Grandstand M.

Grandstand R

Grandstand R is located after Turn 3. It's a great grandstand if you want to see a lot of on-track action, as you also have a view of the Senna S. However, it is more expensive than the nearby Grandstand G, partly because Grandstand R is covered.

Grandstand D

This impressive grandstand is located at Turn 1. From here, you have a fantastic view of the race start. It's also a spot where you'll see a lot of on-track action, simply because many overtakes happen here. This is the most expensive grandstand at the circuit, but if your budget allows, it's definitely worth the price.

Grandstand H

Grandstand H is located at Turn 2. This grandstand offers a view of Turn 2 (Senna S), allowing you to see the cars navigate Turns 2 and 3. This grandstand is very good for its price and is definitely recommended.

Grandstand N

Grandstand N is located at Turn 3, situated between Grandstands H and R. From this grandstand, you can see the cars as they exit the corner and race down the straight. The view here is slightly less than from Grandstand H, but better than from Grandstand R. This grandstand offers good value for its price and is definitely recommended.

Grandstand S

Grandstand S is located at the entry of Turn 4. The cars come off a fast straight and must brake late and hard to navigate Turn 4. This is also a great spot to see overtaking maneuvers.

Grandstand V

Grandstand V is located at the exit of Turn 4. The cars have just come down a fast straight and must brake for Turn 4. As they exit Turn 4, they accelerate through Turn 5 and toward Turn 6. It's possible that a driver will place their car alongside another at this corner, making it an exciting spot for overtakes.
