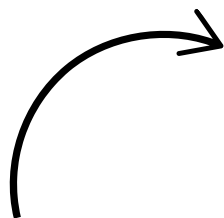

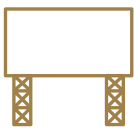
To help you select the right tickets and be prepared for your trip to the Hungarian Grand Prix, we have a few ticket tips for you:



Are you ordering tickets for the same grandstand and the same day in a single purchase? Then you are guaranteed to sit together during the Formula 1 in Hungary.



There are tickets available for children of 13 years old and younger at strongly reduced rates for this event.



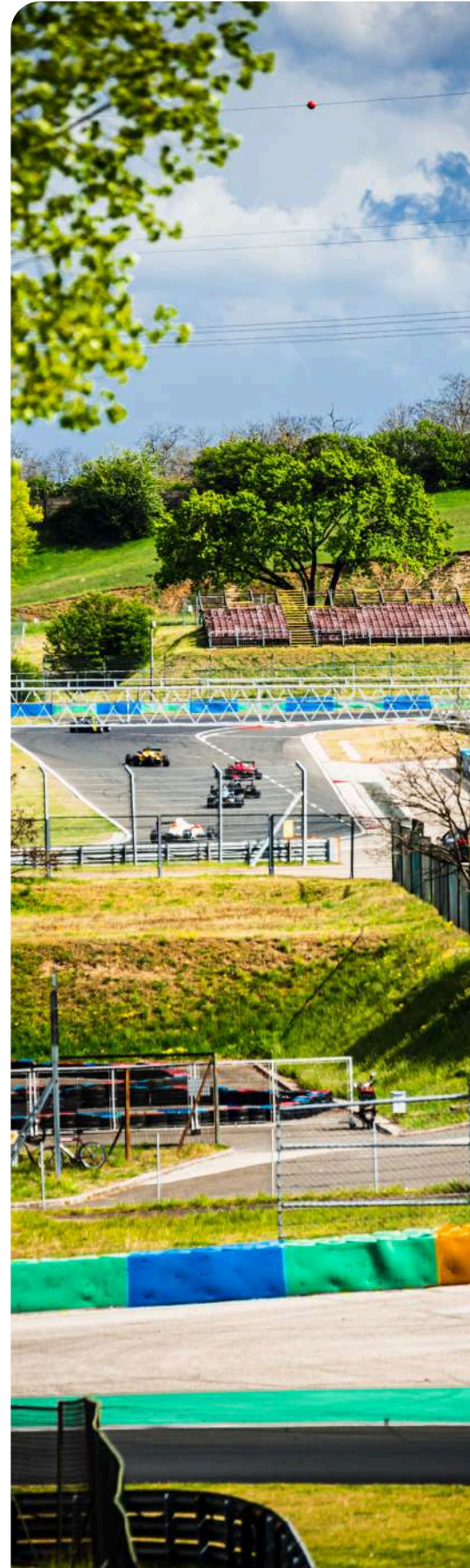
Most of the grandstands on the circuit have access to at least one big screen, though sometimes a little distant. This ensures that you won't miss any of the action on track.



Tickets for race day only (Sunday) are also available at a discount. You save 10% off the price of a three-day ticket (while supplies last).

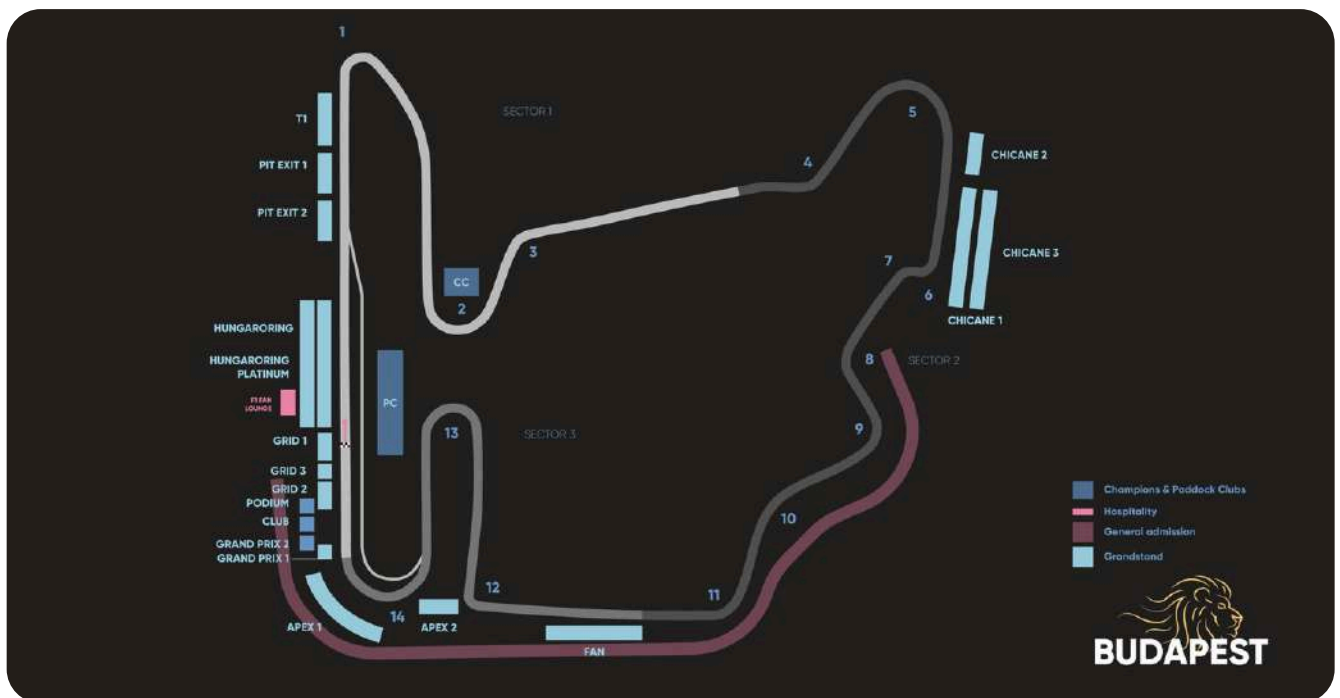


Spaces for wheelchair users are available on the Pit Exit 1 Grandstand & the Hungaroring Grandstand.

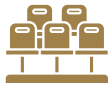


# Grandstand Ticket Options

On the following pages, you will find an overview of the different grandstands available at the Hungaroring circuit in Hungary. For each grandstand, we provide information about the view and what parts of the circuit you can follow, so you can get a clear idea of what to expect and choose the option that suits you best.

## Grandstands

### Hungaroring & Hungaroring Platinum Grandstand

This grandstand is covered and is also the main grandstand of the circuit. It offers a fantastic view of the build-up, start, and finish of the race, as well as the pit lane. You are seated opposite the pit garages of the top Formula 1 teams. The grandstand is divided into the Platinum and Hungaroring sections. The Hungaroring Platinum is located at a higher level, making it more luxurious and providing a better view of the circuit.

In addition, this grandstand has a large TV screen, so you won't miss a single moment of the race action at the Hungaroring.

### Pit Exit Grandstand

Pit Exit offers a good perspective on Turn 1 and, as the name suggests, the pit exit. It increases your chances of seeing many overtaking maneuvers, as this section often experiences a lot of on-track action. With a large TV screen, you won't miss any of the exciting moments at the Hungaroring.

### Turn 1 Grandstand

This is, after the Hungaroring (Platinum) grandstand, the best grandstand at the circuit. The Turn 1 grandstand is located at the apex of Turn 1. Here, you have the best chance to see the most overtaking maneuvers.

There is also a large TV screen at this grandstand, so you won't miss any of the race action.

## **Chicane 1 / 2 / 3 / 4 Grandstand**

The Chicane 3 Grandstand is located above the Chicane 1 and Chicane 2 Grandstands, giving you the widest view of this part of the Hungaroring thanks to its elevated position. Chicane 2 is to the right of Chicane 1, closer to Turn 5. Chicane 4 is located to the left of the Chicane 1 Grandstand, closer to Turns 6 and 7.

Chicane 1 is generally the most affordable of the four. While the view is slightly less optimal compared to the other three grandstands, it is still a good option and offers a quieter experience, making it ideal for those looking for a budget-friendly choice.

## **Fan Grandstand 1 / 2**

The Fan Grandstand is located between Turns 11 and 12, providing a good view of both corners. The Fan Grandstand has a large TV screen so you won't miss any of the race action. The Fan Grandstand was formerly known as Silver 5. Fan Grandstand 2 is located in front of Fan Grandstand 1.

## **Apex 1 / Apex 2 Grandstand**

Located along the extended curve of Turn 14, the Apex 1 Grandstand offers a view of the cars entering and exiting Turn 14. With a good view of the final corner, it is a real fan favorite. The Apex 1 Grandstand has a large TV screen, so you won't miss any of the race action. The Apex 1 Grandstand was formerly known as the Silver 3 Grandstand.

The Apex 2 Grandstand is next to Apex 1. From this grandstand, you can see the cars through Turns 13 and 14. There is also a large TV screen at Apex 2, but it is positioned quite far from the grandstand, making it somewhat harder to see. Of the two, we recommend Apex 1.

## Grand Prix 1 / 2 Grandstand

The Grand Prix 2 Grandstand is located on the straight of the Hungaroring just after the final corner. Its elevated position provides a fantastic panoramic view of the entire circuit. The Grand Prix 2 Grandstand also has a large TV screen, so you won't miss any of the race action. Grand Prix 1 is located below Grand Prix 2, so we prefer Grand Prix 2 due to its higher position.

## Grid 1 Grandstand

The Grid 1 Grandstand is located on the straight of the Hungaroring, next to the Hungaroring Grandstand. The location is right on the start/finish line.

The Grid 1 Grandstand also provides a good view of the pit lane, allowing you to follow strategies live. This makes it an excellent spot to watch the starts of the various races over the weekend. With a large TV screen in front of the grandstand, you won't miss any race action on the circuit.

## Grid 2 Grandstand

The Grid 2 Grandstand is located on the start/finish straight. It offers a fantastic view of the straight and the pit lane. From the grandstand, you can follow all strategies live and watch the race build-up up close. This grandstand has a large TV screen, so you won't miss any of the race action.

## Grid 3 Grandstand

Grid 3 is also located along the start/finish straight. From this grandstand, you have a clear view of the final corner of the circuit, the race start, and the podium ceremony afterward.

## General Admission

Like the Red Bull Ring, the Hungaroring is naturally located in a valley. The General Admission areas around the circuit therefore offer excellent elevated viewing opportunities, especially between Turns 9 and 14.

Many of the grass-covered standing areas are on higher ground behind the grandstands, particularly at the final Turn 14. This is why this location ranks in our top 3 of all standing areas across the entire F1 calendar.

Although the circuit is relatively far away, you still get a fantastic panoramic view of large parts of the track, including the starting grid! Bring binoculars so you can follow the action everywhere. These are some of the most affordable and best General Admission tickets on the F1 calendar!
