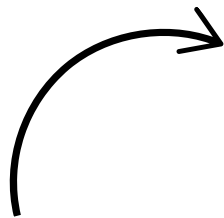

Ticket Tips

To help you select the right tickets and be prepared for your trip to the Grand Prix of Las Vegas, we have a few ticket tips for you:



Are you ordering tickets for the same grandstand and the same day in a single purchase? Then you are guaranteed to sit together during the Formula 1 in Las Vegas.



Children are allowed to attend the Las Vegas Grand Prix. Children under 2 years old do not need a ticket to enter the Las Vegas circuit.



Most of the grandstands on the circuit have access to at least one big screen. This ensures that you won't miss any of the action on track.

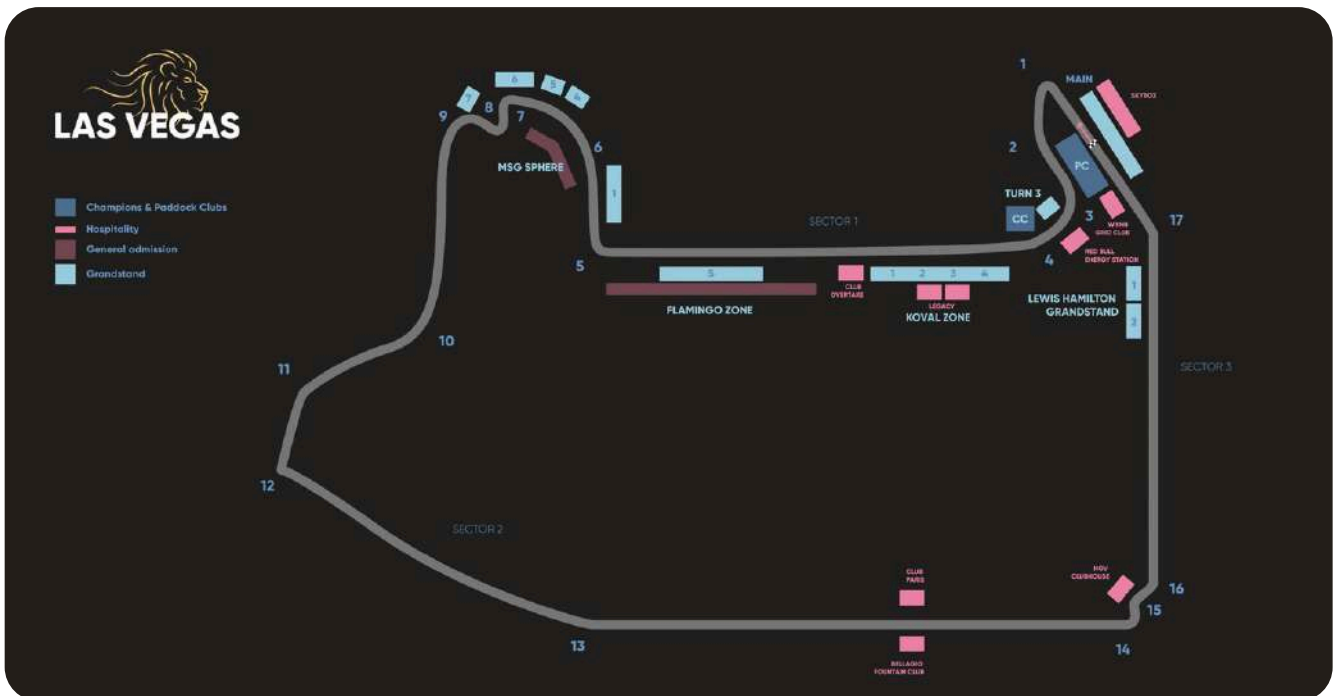


Please note that the race itself will take place on Saturday.



Grandstand Ticket Options

On the following pages, you will find an overview of the different grandstands available at the Las Vegas Circuit in the United States. For each grandstand, we provide information about the view and what parts of the circuit you can follow, so you can get a clear idea of what to expect and choose the option that suits you best.

Sphere Grandstands

The grandstands in the Sphere zone are located between Turns 5 and 9. There are five possible grandstands to choose from (SG1, SG4, SG5, SG6, and SG7), all situated around the famous Las Vegas Sphere. All grandstands have a large TV screen, so you won't miss a moment of the race action.

From the **SG1 Grandstand**, you can see the cars exit the slower Turn 5 and accelerate toward the faster Turn 6. The view is somewhat obstructed by advertising boards and structures, but sitting lower provides a nice view of the circuit.

Grandstands SG4, SG5, and SG6 are the best spots in the Sphere zone. Here, you get a fantastic view of Turns 6, 7, and 8. These are also the more expensive grandstands in this zone.

The **SG7 Grandstand** offers a different perspective, allowing you to see the cars coming directly toward you rather than from the side. If you sit higher up, you may also be able to see Turn 9 behind you, although your view may be partially blocked by structures. In the lower rows, this will be less of an issue.



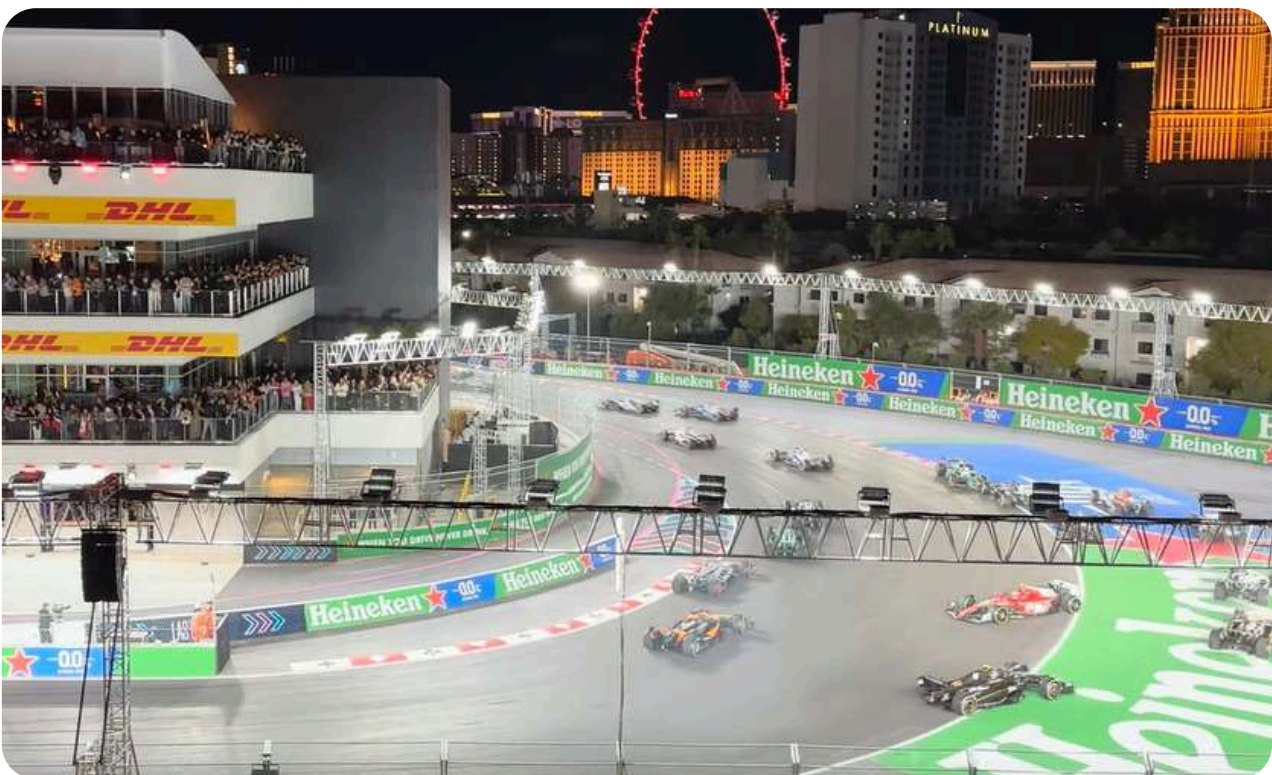
View from the SG5 Grandstand

East Harmon Zone

The **Main Grandstand** in the East Harmon Zone is located along the start/finish straight, allowing you to experience all the action as the cars accelerate off the starting line, cover the short straight, and approach the first corner. This grandstand also offers an excellent view of the pit lane and team strategies, letting you witness the thrilling moments of pit stops and tire changes. With its prime location, the Main Grandstand provides a perfect mix of speed, drama, and the electric atmosphere of Las Vegas.

West Harmon Zone

The West Harmon Zone is located at the final corner of the circuit. From the grandstands in this zone, the **Lewis Hamilton Grandstands**, you can see the cars pass by at full speed heading toward Turn 17. There are two grandstands in this group, Lewis Hamilton 1 and Lewis Hamilton 2. They are next to each other, so there isn't much difference in the view, but Lewis Hamilton 1 is slightly closer to Turn 17. These grandstands in the West Harmon Zone are the most affordable at the Las Vegas circuit.

General Admission

General Admission at the Las Vegas Grand Prix provides access to a viewing platform, but seating is unreserved, so it's essential to arrive early to secure a spot. Each ticket grants access to the specific GA zone purchased, meaning fans cannot freely move between different GA areas.

The **T-Mobile General Admission** Zone at the Sphere is located between Turns 5 and 7. This is the largest GA zone and, in our opinion, the best. It offers a good view of the chicane at Turns 7 and 8. You also get free access to all concerts at the Las Vegas circuit.

The **Flamingo Zone** is on the Koval Straight between Turns 4 and 5. From here, you get a good view of the cars as they speed down the straight.

Finally, there is the **Caesars Palace General Admission** area, located on the Las Vegas Strip just after Turn 13. You have a view of one of the longest straights on the Formula 1 calendar.
