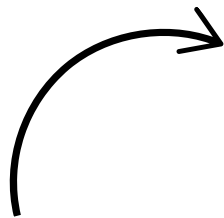

# Ticket Tips

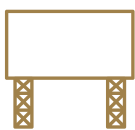
To help you select the right tickets and be prepared for your trip to the Grand Prix of Mexico, we have a few ticket tips for you:



Are you ordering tickets for the same grandstand and the same day in a single purchase? Then you are guaranteed to sit together during the Formula 1 in Mexico.



Children under 4 years old get free admission but are not allowed to occupy a seat. Unfortunately, there are no discounts for children aged 4 to 18. Additionally, all children must be accompanied by an adult.



Most of the grandstands on the circuit have access to at least one big screen. This ensures that you won't miss any of the action on track.



After the race, fans can take part in the track invasion and get a close-up view of the podium ceremony. If you want to experience this, choose a grandstand close to the podium.

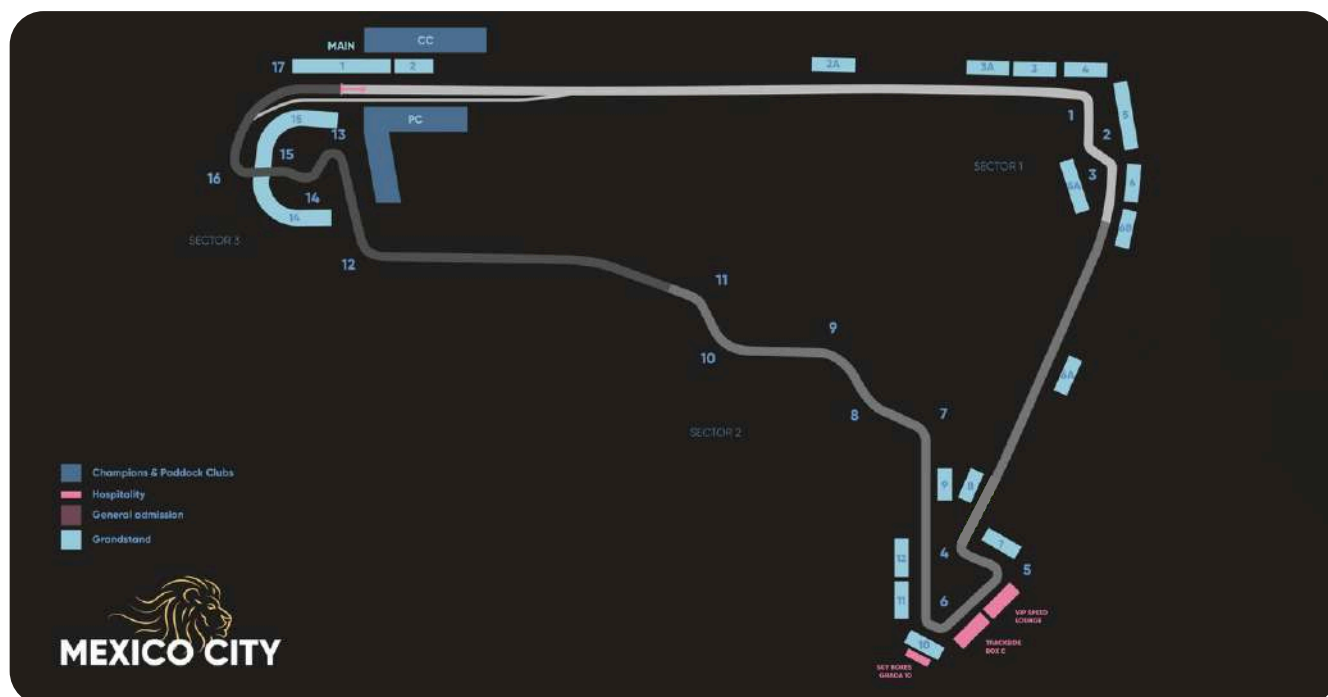


Keep in mind that the circuit is divided into colour-coded zones. If you have a grandstand ticket for a specific zone, you cannot access the other zones.

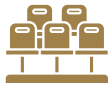


# Grandstand Ticket Options

On the following pages, you will find an overview of the different grandstands available at the Autódromo Hermanos Rodríguez circuit in Mexico. For each grandstand, we provide information about the view and what parts of the circuit you can follow, so you can get a clear idea of what to expect and choose the option that suits you best.

## Grandstands

### Grandstand 3 & 3A

Grandstand 3 & 3A are located just before Turn 1, near the braking zone. Here, the cars slow down from speeds of up to 300 km/h. From these grandstands, you get a fantastic view of the start and the first corner, and you'll likely witness some spectacular overtaking maneuvers. The grandstands are located next to each other, however, Grandstand 3 is located a little closer to turn 1

### Grandstand 4

Grandstand 4 is located close to Grandstand 3 but is situated right at the first corner of the circuit. You get a fantastic view of the opening sequence of corners, including Turns 1, 2, and 3. You'll be able to follow the thrilling opening moments of the race perfectly! This grandstand offers an up-close experience of one of the most exciting parts of the circuit.

### Grandstand 5 / 5A

Grandstand 5 is located between Turns 1 and 2, just after the main straight. Like Grandstand 4, you get a fantastic view of the first three corners, but from a slightly different angle. From this grandstand, you can follow the thrilling opening phase of the race and exciting overtaking maneuvers.

Grandstand 5A is also at this corner combination near Turn 3. However, this grandstand is located on the inside of the circuit, offering a slightly different perspective.

## **Grandstand 6**

Another grandstand at this corner combination is Grandstand 6. It is located opposite Grandstand 5A on the outside of the circuit. From here, you can see the cars exiting the Turn 1–3 combination and accelerating toward the second straight of the circuit.

## **Grandstand 6A**

Grandstand 6A is located along the second straight of the Mexico City Circuit. You'll see the cars speeding past on this straight. However, it's not one of the most action-packed areas of the circuit, as there are no corners in view.

## **Grandstand 6B**

Grandstand 6B is the last grandstand in this corner combination. It is located next to Grandstand 6. From here, you can see the cars exiting Turn 3 and heading onto the second straight. This grandstand is not covered.

## **Grandstand 7**

Grandstand 7 is located between Turns 4 and 5 on the Mexico City Circuit. You get a good view of the corner combination of Turns 4, 5, and 6. It's a great spot to watch the race and enjoy the on-track action.

## **Grandstand 8**

Grandstand 8 is an excellent choice for fans who want a great view of the action at Turns 4 and 5. Located on the inside of the circuit, this grandstand offers a unique perspective of the cars as they navigate these challenging corners. It's an ideal spot to see the technical side of the race while the drivers tackle these key sections of the circuit.

## **Grandstand 9**

Grandstand 9 is located just before Turn 7, making it a great spot to follow the action in both Turns 6 and 7. Positioned on the inside of the circuit, it offers an excellent view of a technically challenging section of the track. It's an ideal place to watch the drivers navigate these corners and is often a key area for overtaking and race strategy.

## **Grandstand 10**

Grandstand 10 is located in a prime spot at Turn 6 on the Mexico circuit. From this grandstand, you have a fantastic view of the corner sequence from Turns 4, 5, and 6, as well as part of Turn 7. This location offers a wide and clear perspective of the action through these corners.

## **Grandstand 11**

Grandstand 11 is located just after Turn 6. It offers a good view of Turns 4, 5, 6, and 7, allowing you to follow the race action through multiple corners. You'll see the cars brake hard for Turn 4 and navigate the slightly slower section before accelerating again toward the esses.

## **Grandstand 14**

Grandstand 14 is located at Turns 14 and 15 of the circuit, offering a fantastic view of Turns 13, 14, and 15. Part of the grandstand is covered, providing extra comfort. Additionally, the location offers a good view of the podium after the race, as it is also situated in the stadium section of the circuit.

## Grandstand 15

Grandstand 15 is located at Turn 15 of the circuit, offering a fantastic view of Turns 13, 14, and 15. Like Grandstand 14, part of Grandstand 15 is covered, providing extra comfort. This grandstand also offers a great view of the podium celebrations, as they take place within the stadium section.

## Grandstand 1 / 2

Grandstands 1 and 2, also known as the main grandstands, are located along the start/finish straight. The main grandstand offers an excellent view of the race start and finish. From here, you can witness the race start, pit stops, and the opening ceremonies.

In addition, you have access to the food and drink zone behind the grandstands, where you can easily grab a taco, get a drink at the Heineken bar, or take a spin on the simulator.
