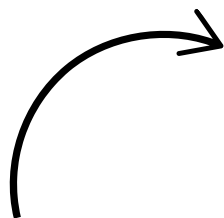

Are you planning to attend the Portuguese Grand Prix and unsure which tickets suit you best? In this ticket guide, you will find practical tips to help you make the right choice. We briefly explain the differences between the ticket options and what to look out for.

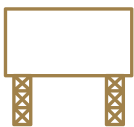
To help you select the right tickets and be prepared for your trip to the Grand Prix of Portugal, we have a few ticket tips for you:



Are you ordering tickets for the same grandstand and the same day in a single purchase? Then you are guaranteed to sit together during the Formula 1 in Portugal.



Child discounts are available for the 2–14 age group. Please note: the discount is only valid if your child is 14 years old or younger at the time of the Portuguese Grand Prix. You select the desired child tickets under the “Child Tickets 2–14 years” category.



Most of the grandstands on the circuit have access to at least one big screen. This ensures that you won't miss any of the action on track.

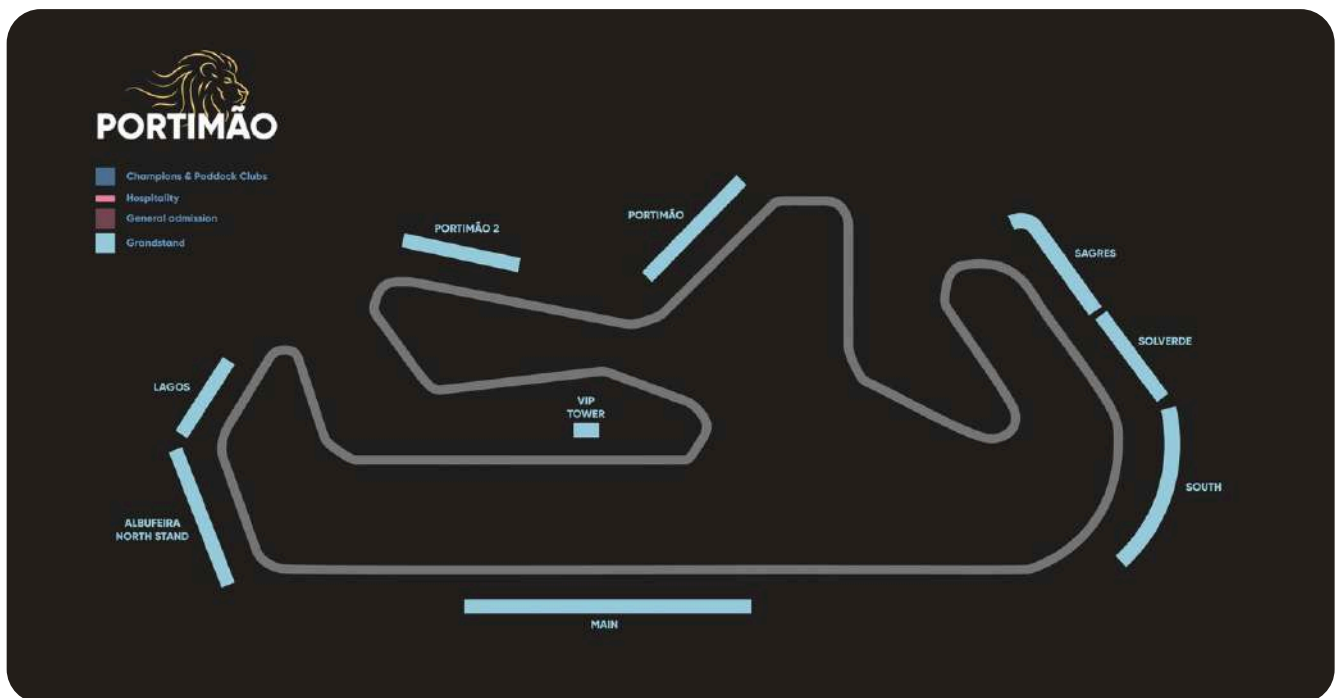


The view from the grandstands at Portimão is generally limited to one or two corners. Some grandstands have an exclusive ‘premium’ section at the top. This area is covered and offers a better, panoramic view of the track. In addition, the roof provides some protection from the weather.

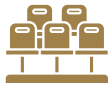


Grandstand Ticket Options

On the following pages, you will find an overview of the different grandstands available for the Autódromo Internacional do Algarve circuit (also known as Portimão) in Portugal. For each grandstand, we provide information about the view and what parts of the circuit you can follow, so you can get a clear idea of what to expect and choose the option that suits you best.

Grandstands

Grandstand Albufeira/North Stand

The first grandstand at the Portimão circuit is the Albufeira / North Stand. From this grandstand, you have a good view of Turns 1 and 2, with Turn 1 being one of the best spots for overtakes. The Albufeira / North Stand consists of four to five smaller sections, so the view can vary depending on the section. This grandstand is not covered.

Lagos Grandstand

The Lagos Grandstand is located directly next to the Albufeira/North Stand. From this grandstand, you get an excellent view of Turns 2 and 3. Turn 3 is undoubtedly the slowest corner on the Portimão circuit and also makes a great spot for overtakes. This grandstand is not covered.

Main Grandstand

The Main Grandstand is the primary grandstand at the Portimão circuit. Like other Main Grandstands, it offers a view of the pit lane and the start/finish straight. The advantage of the Main Grandstand at Portimão is that it is located at the highest point of the circuit, giving you a good view of a large portion of the track. It is also the only covered grandstand.

Portimão 2 Grandstand

The Portimão 2 Grandstand is located between Turns 8 and 9. From this grandstand, you have a good view of both fast corners, which run both uphill and downhill, offering a special and unique perspective, especially within Formula 1. This grandstand is not covered.

Portimão Grandstand

The Portimão Grandstand is located between Turns 9 and 10. From this grandstand, you have a good view of Turns 9, 10, and 11. Turns 10 and 11 are two of the most unique corners on the circuit: Turn 10 is a fast left-hander that goes uphill, while Turn 11 descends. These two corners are characteristic of the circuit and make it especially spectacular to watch from the grandstand.

Sagres Grandstand

The Sagres Grandstand is located after Turn 14. From this grandstand, you have a good view of Turn 14 and the start of Turn 15. Due to the nature of the circuit, Turns 14 and 15 are a bit further apart. The Sagres Grandstand is one of the three large grandstands between Turns 14 and 15 and is not covered.

Solverde Grandstand

The Solverde Grandstand is the second of the three grandstands located between Turns 14 and 15. From this grandstand, you have a good view of Turns 14 and 15, two very unique corners at the Autódromo Internacional do Algarve. You also have a view of Turn 13 on the other side of the circuit, as that corner is situated at a lower elevation.

South Grandstand

The South Grandstand is located at Turn 15. From this grandstand, you have a good view of the end of Turn 14 and Turn 15. You can also see the drivers as they head up the straight, although the start/finish line is not visible due to the steep incline of the straight. It offers a unique perspective to watch the Formula 1 cars in action. This grandstand is not covered.

General Admission

The General Admission areas at the Autódromo Internacional do Algarve are spacious and offer good views of the circuit. The most popular spot is at Turn 1, next to the Main Grandstand. Throughout the circuit, there are plenty of opportunities to find a spot, including around the final corner, where ample General Admission areas are also available.
