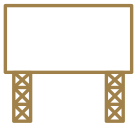
To help you select the right tickets and be prepared for your trip to the Grand Prix of Singapore, we have a few ticket tips for you:



Are you ordering tickets for the same grandstand and the same day in a single purchase? Then you are guaranteed to sit together during the Formula 1 in Singapore.



Singapore is known for its concerts, which take place every evening on two main stages in Zone 1 and Zone 4 (Padang Stage). Please note: if you want to see one of the musical acts, make sure your admission ticket grants access to the zone where the concert is held.



Most of the grandstands on the circuit have access to at least one big screen. This ensures that you won't miss any of the action on track.



The Marina Bay Circuit is divided into four zones. The zone you are in determines your access and freedom to move around the circuit. The more expensive grandstand tickets (and Premier Walkabout tickets) provide access to all four zones, while other tickets restrict your access to only one or at most two zones.



Day tickets are only available for certain ticket categories, including Walkabout (standing areas).



Grandstand Ticket Options

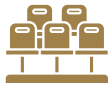
On the following pages, you will find an overview of the different grandstands available at the Marina Bay Street circuit in Singapore. For each grandstand, we provide information about the view and what parts of the circuit you can follow, so you can get a clear idea of what to expect and choose the option that suits you best.

Singapore is one of the most beautiful and longest circuits on the F1 calendar. It is also a tough challenge for the drivers, who must keep a cool head in the hot and humid conditions. Even the smallest mistake can have major consequences here.

Whichever option you choose, you unfortunately won't see much more than the section of track directly in front of you. That's simply the nature of a street circuit. However, the excitement of F1 action under artificial lights against Singapore's enchanting night skyline more than makes up for it. Add in the lively atmosphere around the circuit and the daily concerts featuring major artists, and you have the ingredients for a truly unique race experience.

Grandstands

Pit Straight Grandstand

The Pit Straight Grandstand is located on the main straight of the Singapore circuit. From here, you have an excellent view of the grid build-up and the start of the race, as well as the podium ceremony after the race. This grandstand is one of the more expensive options in Singapore.

Turn 1 Grandstand

The Turn 1 Grandstand offers a fantastic view of Turn 1 in Singapore. You can watch the start of the race perfectly from here. You will witness cars braking hard or attempting overtakes on their rivals. This grandstand is also one of the more expensive options at the Singapore circuit.

Turn 2 Grandstand

The Turn 2 Grandstand offers you a nice view over the first three corners of the circuit and the straight. You will be able to see the start of the race and possible overtakes happening in turn 1. This grandstand is one of the most expensive options on the Singapore Circuit. But if you have the budget for it, we definitely recommend it!

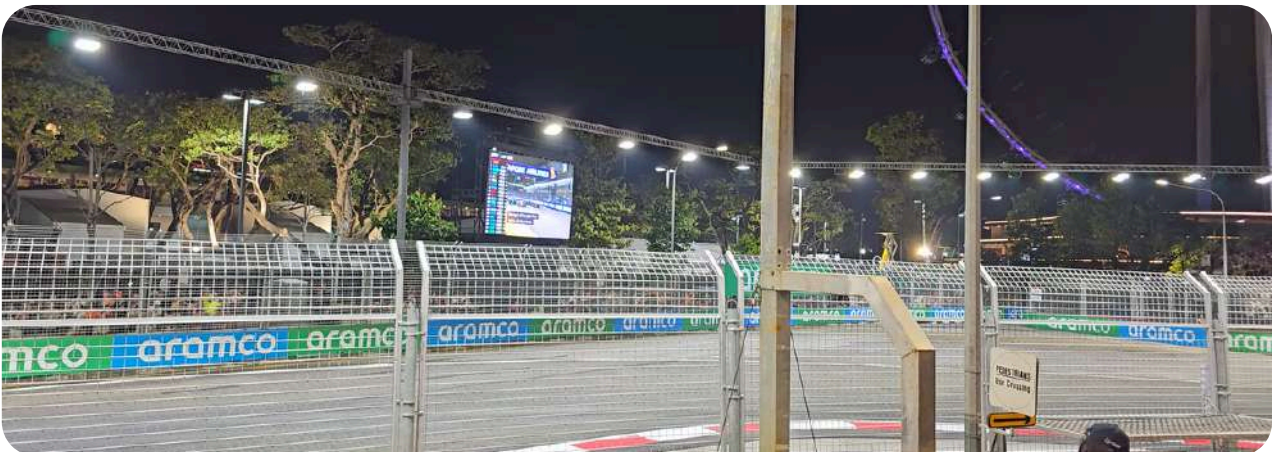
Pit Exit Grandstand

The Pit Exit Grandstand is located on the inside of the first corner, where you can see the cars braking for Turn 1. As the name suggests, this grandstand also gives you a great view of the pit exit, as it is almost directly in front of it. From here, you can watch the cars coming out of the pit lane onto the circuit, a really excellent spot!

Chicane @ Turn 1 & 2 Grandstands

Chicane @ Turn 1 is located, as the name suggests, on the inside of Turns 1 and 2. From this grandstand, you have a great view of Turns 1-3 and the pit exit, where you might witness an overtaking maneuver.

Chicane @ Turn 2 is next to Chicane @ Turn 1, but closer to Turn 3. The view is similar to the other Chicane grandstand, but more focused on the third corner of the circuit.

Republic Grandstand

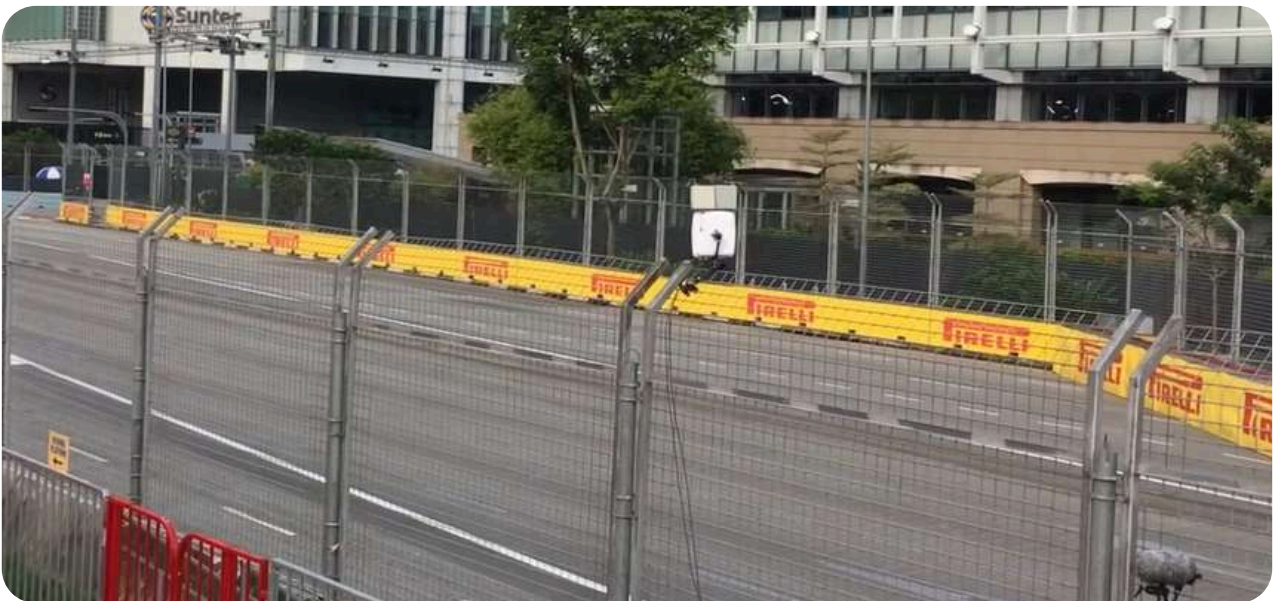
The Republic Grandstand is located at Turn 5. You can see the cars approaching at full speed from Turn 4 before watching them navigate the kink of Turn 5. This is one of the more affordable grandstands at the Singapore circuit.

Raffles Grandstand

The Raffles Grandstand is located at the apex of Turn 5 on the circuit. From here, you can watch the drivers take the sharp corner as precisely as possible to get a good exit onto one of the long straights of the circuit. You are on the left side of the track, which also gives you a view of the Formula 1 paddock. These tickets are on the more expensive side for the Singapore circuit.

Stamford Grandstand

The Stamford Grandstand is located between Turns 7 and 8. It is one of the spots where overtaking is possible for the drivers. The cars approach at high speed from the first straight and then have to brake hard for Turn 7.

Padang A / B Grandstand

The Padang Grandstands are located between Turns 9 and 10. You will witness the cars coming out of Turn 9, accelerating, and then entering the sharp Turn 10. These are the most affordable grandstands on the circuit, along with the Connaught Grandstand.

Padang A is closer to Turn 9. From here, you can see the cars coming out of Turn 9 and building speed toward Turn 10. Padang B, on the other hand, is closer to Turn 10. From this position, you get a better view of the cars braking for the tenth corner of the circuit.

Empress Grandstand

Between Turns 11 and 12, you'll find the Empress Grandstand. From here, you can see the cars exiting Turn 11 and heading towards Turn 12. This is one of the smaller grandstands, but you are very close to the circuit. This grandstand is also one of the more affordable options at the Marina Bay Street Circuit in Singapore.

Connaught Grandstand

The Connaught Grandstand is located at Turn 14. This is a braking zone after a straight, which the drivers need to judge precisely to get a good exit onto the next straight. You will see the cars braking from very close up, and you might even witness an overtaking maneuver into Turn 14.

This is the most affordable grandstand, along with the Padang Tribune. We definitely recommend this grandstand if it fits within your budget.

Bayfront Grandstand

On the outside of Turn 17, you'll find the Bayfront Grandstand. From this grandstand, you can see the cars exiting Turn 16, navigating Turn 17, and heading toward the final corners of the circuit.

Promenade Grandstand

The Promenade Grandstand is located between Turns 17 and 18. From this grandstand, you can see the cars exiting Turn 17 and racing toward the final corners of the circuit.


General Admission


Walkabout tickets at Marina Bay are the equivalent of general admission tickets at other races. You don't get an assigned seat and can move freely within a designated area. There are elevated viewing platforms around the circuit, some of which offer unobstructed views of the track. In general, your view of the track may be partially blocked with these standing tickets, and at some points, you'll only get a brief glimpse of the cars on the circuit.

The best days to make the most of Walkabout tickets are Friday and Saturday, as fewer fans are competing for space on the viewing platforms. A good strategy is to explore the different viewpoints on the first days, then choose your preferred spot and arrive early on Sunday to claim it before the race.

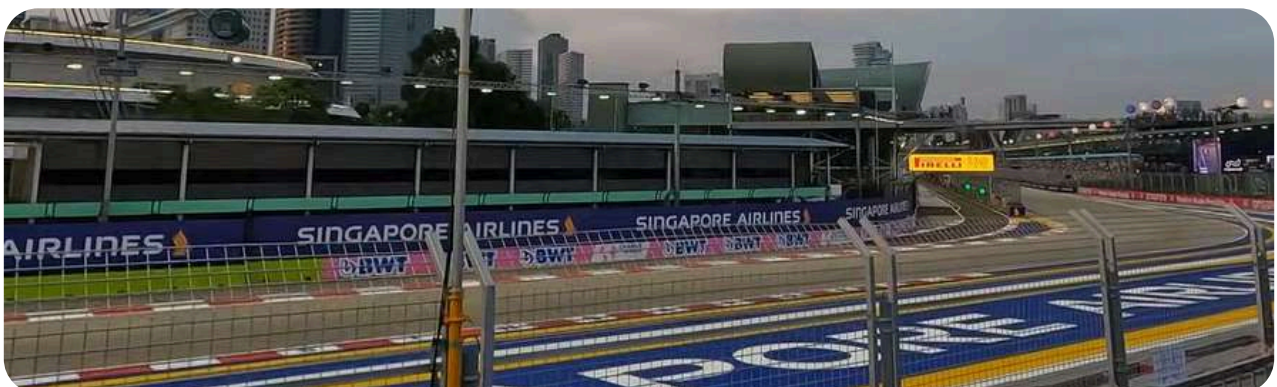
Two types of Walkabout Tickets

There are two types of Walkabout tickets sold in Singapore: one for Zone 4 only and one for all zones (Premier Walkabout). Both are available as three-day tickets.

The more expensive Premier Walkabout tickets provide access to Zones 1 through 4. In general, there are far fewer fans in Zone 1, which means you have a better chance of securing a good spot along the track. Some of the best viewing areas are the opening Turns 1–3, Turn 5 (where you can get very close to the action), and the final corners, 18–19.

Zone 4 tickets are a good budget option, giving access to the viewing platforms on Esplanade Drive and Raffles Avenue. In addition, you get access to the biggest concerts at the Padang stage. However, these tickets only grant access to Zone 4.
